POSTEL'S 2021 ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF NEWLY ELECTED OFFICIALS,

There will be no nominations from the floor. The election of officials will not be conducted by ballot when there is only one nominee for each position to be filled. For members wishing to be nominated by petition, the procedures are as follows:

BILL PRESSON

Bill Presson, native Wichitan, attended schools in Wichita ISD and MSU. Bill was an employee of TxDot, retiring after 30 plus years as District Maintenance Manager.
