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EPICENTER: Kentucky Derby runners-up have a poor Preakness history, just 1 winner since 1993 (Exaggerator '16), and the Derby favorites like Epicenter are only 3-for-9 here since 2011. The last Louisville losing favorite to rebound at Pimlico was Lookin At Lucky ('10). That said, his Derby effort was outstanding and he's had the deepest 2022 resume of any sophomore in his class. The likely favorite.



SECRET OATH: She'll try the Rachel Alexandra redux from 2009, catapulting from the Kentucky Oaks winner's circle to the Preakness. Rachel held off Mine That Bird to cement her place as one of just 5 fillies to secure the Preakness trophy. Secret Oath was a game third in the Arkansas Derby in a prior attempt vs. the colts for 86-year-old trainer D. Wayne Lukas, whose 6 Preakness wins are third-most all-time.



EARLY VOTING:: The Wood Memorial runner-up hails from the same owner-trainer and Preakness path that brought you Cloud Computing's 13-1 upset five years ago. Trainer Chad Brown finished third in the Kentucky Derby with Zandon and deputizes this stablemate for the middle jewel of the Triple Crown, awaiting the Belmont Stakes with the other. Expect Early Voting to be heard from in the early pace.



SIMPLIFICATION: Rallying fourth-place finisher in the run for the roses, his 3-1/2 length loss came after making up more than 8 lengths. Simplification won the Fountain of Youth Stakes at Gulfstream Park in March, a race whose winner last added the Preakness in 1995 with Thunder Gulch. Derby rider Jose Ortiz jumps to ride Early Voting, so Hall of Famer John Velazquez is welcomed aboard.



SKIPPYLONGSTOCKING: This son of 2016 Preakness winner Exaggerator will be seeking his first career stakes win. He finished third in the Wood Memorial most recently, and will need to make up 3-1/2 lengths on Preakness re-matcher Early Voting. Trainer Saffie Joseph Jr. puts this one in the middle jewel after his Florida Derby winner White Abarrio disappointed in 16th in Louisville.



CREATIVE MINISTER: The mostly lightly raced horse in the Preakness cast has but 3 starts to his ledger, winning a Kentucky Derby Day undercard allowance among the hullabaloo. Sire Creative Cause was third in the 2012 Preakness, and trainer Kenny McPeek saddled 2020 autumn Preakness-winning filly Swiss Skydiver.



HANDICAP PREAKNESS LIKE EDDIE OLCZYK



Just as we did 2 weeks ago for the Kentucky Derby, we asked renowned 1/ST and NBC handicapper Eddie Olczyk which handicapping angles he applies when analyzing the Preakness Stakes. "Not a lot changes from the Derby to the Preakness," Olczyk said. "I'm not looking to invent a new dance or anything. These horses are fresh on the minds of horseplayers and they've got your attention. Most of the same handicapping fundamentals apply."

IN THE MIX

"Just like the Derby, you want a Preakness horse in contention when they hit the top of the stretch, like Rombauer was a year ago," Olczyk reasoned. "Other than Exaggerator in the slop (2016), you won't find deep closers having a lot of win-end Preakness success in the past decade. Because of the immediate relevance of the Derby, consider adding in speed and pace factors for the most recent race as well as those further-reaching.

IN THE GENES

"While the Preakness distance is a bit shorter than the Derby," Olczyk explained, "it is still farther than most 3-year-olds want to run, and farther than the newcomers to the Triple Crown series likely have run in their careers. The Derby horses are proven at the trip, but pedigree can still be the measuring stick for the fresh faces."

EYE ON THE SKY

"It's springtime, and you never know when a wet track will become a storyline," Olczyk said. "Be prepared for which horses might benefit if conditions warrant."

FAST EARLY, FILLY LATE

ANALYSIS: Pace played an important role in the Kentucky Derby outcome, no doubt the leading role in the epic upset. While I don't expect the Derby pace to repeat in the Preakness, I'm heavily counting on good-to-fast fractions at Pimlico. With ARMAGNAC and EARLY VOTING expected up front, you've got the tactical EPICENTER close by. But also consider SKIPPYLONGSTOCKING to be closer to the pace than usual, the longshot FENWICK has one chance going early and there's even blinkers on another longshot HAPPY JACK that could play a role in the pace.

MAIN CONTENDERS: Just like the Derby, EPICENTER is the horse to beat and was the horse to beat in Louisville until all hell broke loose in the final strides. The races he's run – improving, improvin

VALUE PLAYS: \$150,000 supplement CREATIVE MINISTER was visually impressive in his Churchill allowance win and Kenny McPeek is aggressive, but calculated. He could run this horse anywhere else and probably be 3-5. This colt should trip out positively. SIMPLIFICATION had the worst trip of all in the Derby and still ran very well. I've been on him since early in the year and he always seems to try.

EARLY VOTING CAN SWAY PREAKNESS RACE

ANALYSIS: So, you didn't have Rich Strike at 80-1 in the Kentucky Derby? All is forgiven, fellow handicappers, with an expectation such chaos won't follow at Pimlico. Why? There have been exactly 2 winners in 146 past editions of the Preakness to win at 20-1 or more. Not 80. But 20. The truest of all the Triple Crown races comes off back-to-back 11-1 winners, Rombauer and Swiss Skydiver. But expect that modest madness to end Saturday. While you don't have to settle for the shortest price, attention here should focus on just three major players.

MAIN CONTENDERS: EPICENTER consistently has been America's best 3-year-old in 2022. The way he turned away the full, on-rushing momentum of Zandon in the Kentucky Derby may have been his best act to date, only to be shocked in the final yards by Rich Strike. The stout Preakness favorite will have another challenge to thwart, but likely in front of him, in EARLY VOTING. He's been in my Pimlico crosshairs since the moment he nearly wired the Wood Memorial. His Baltimore native owner Seth Klarman turned away Derby temptation with Cloud Computing in 2017 off similar form and the plan paid off. This one is capable of repeating the feat. The filly SECRET OATH has done zero wrong in '22, and if not for a poorly timed ride by since-replaced Luis Contreras in the Arkansas Derby, I'm convinced she'd have won that, too. Look for Luis Saez to have her making the best, last move in the field trying to catch EARLY VOTING and EPICENTER. Her best chance is if a third early speed horse enters the pace tussle, perhaps ARMAGNAC or SKIPPYLONGSTOCKING.

VALUE PLAYS: I'm only looking at prices on the bottom of the exotics, trusting the trio above to handle the exacta at minimum, if not the trifecta. CREATIVE MINISTER has the most upside in the field in terms of untapped potential, while honest-as-they-come SIMPLIFICATION outran his 35-1 odds at Churchill and should be moving late with the filly for a share.

A WINNING GAME PLAN FOR EARLY VOTING

ANALYSIS: Disregarding injury, illness, or unique circumstances, no Kentucky Derby winner has bypassed the Preakness since 1985, when the connections of Spend A Buck, enticed by a \$2 million bonus, opted to run their colt in the Jersey Derby at the newly reopened Garden State Park. Spend a Buck won in New Jersey, but forfeited his chance for racing immortality, just as Rich Strike has done by being withheld from the Triple Crown's middle jewel. However, even without the 80-1 Derby-winning colt in the field, who might have been no better than fourth choice had he been entered, the Preakness remains an American Classic, a signature race for 3-year-olds, and a good gambling opportunity for players trying to cash a ticket at a square price.

MAIN CONTENDERS: Derby runner-up EPICENTER has been listed as the 6-5 morning line favorite after performing superbly in Louisville. The main concern is whether the Steve Asmussen-trained colt will regress after a hard, taxing race following just two weeks of rest, the same reason ostensibly given by the connections of Rich Strike for not entering the Preakness. There are no such worries with EARLY VOTING, who bypassed the Derby to specifically target the Preakness, a similar game plan employed by trainer Chad Brown and owner, Baltimore native Seth Klarman, with their 2017 Preakness winner Cloud Computing. Fresh as a daisy and the likely controlling speed in the nine-runner field, EARLY VOTING is the listed second choice at 7-2 and offers a reasonable wager at or near that price. Kentucky Oaks winner SECRET OATH will get plenty of play as well, but in her case she will need to step forward significantly, though she certainly could finish in the money.

VALUE PLAYS: If you are looking for a reasonable price to crack the trifecta, the lightly-raced, unproven, but highly-promising CREATIVE MINISTER fits the bill. Fast on numbers and with a style that suggests this race's 9.5-furlong trip will promote his late-running kick, the Ken McPeek-trained colt is listed at 10-1 on the morning line and should be every bit of that on the tote.
