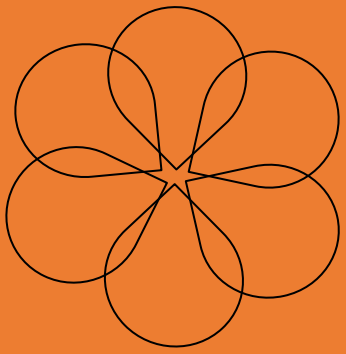

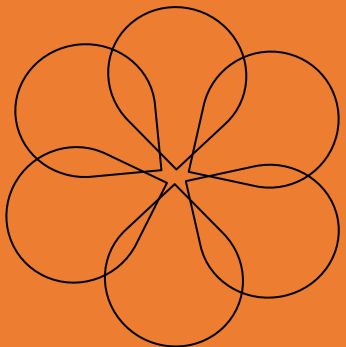

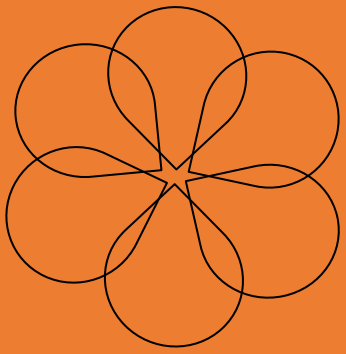
What is **ALLEMED**?

- **ALLEMED** is a working model to make interdisciplinary dialogue and interaction to achieve the goals of The leisure declaration!
- The goal is to include all children and youth in recreational activities, regardless of the financial situation of the families

The leisure declaration



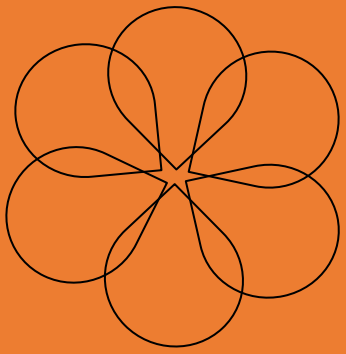


Why **ALLEMED**?

11,7 % of all children below 18 years

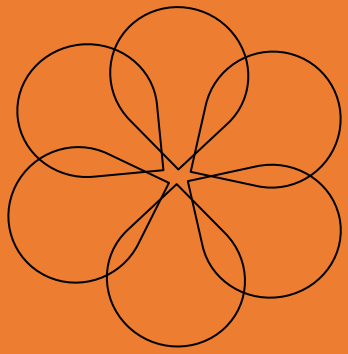
Or 2-3 in every school class



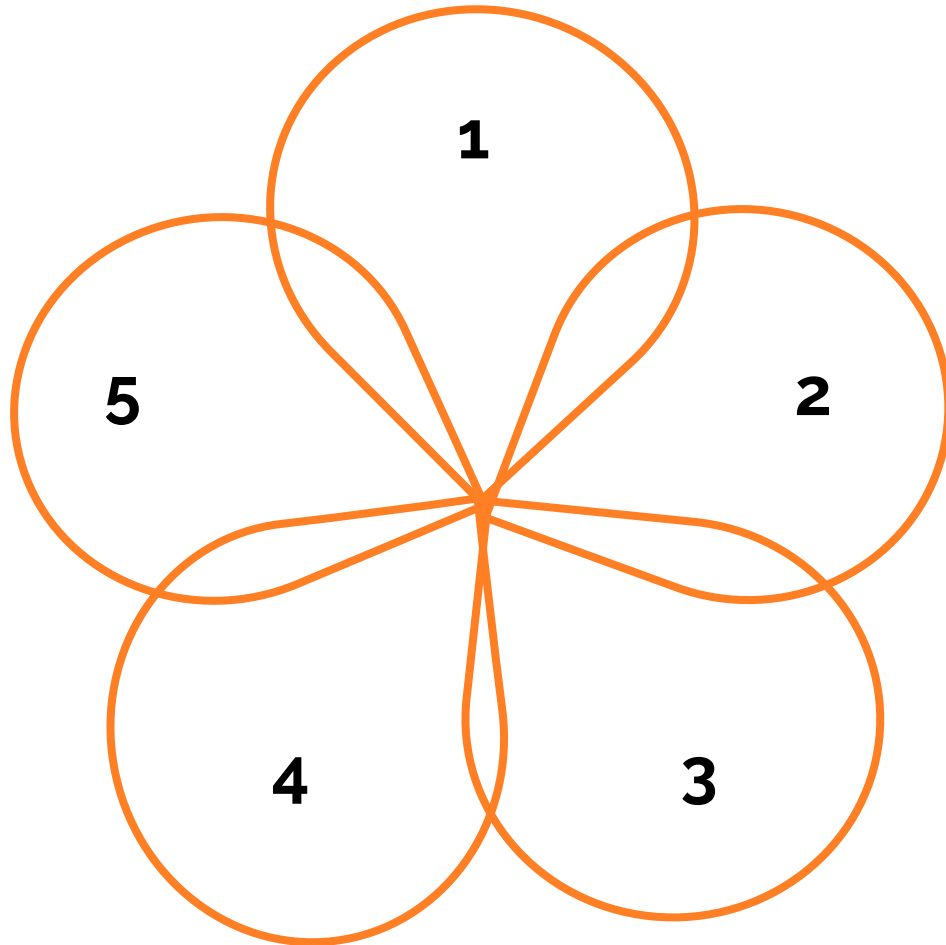
Who are these children?

Children in households

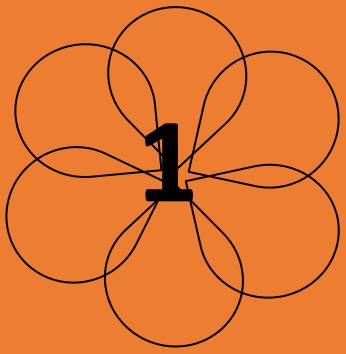
- ... with an immigrant background

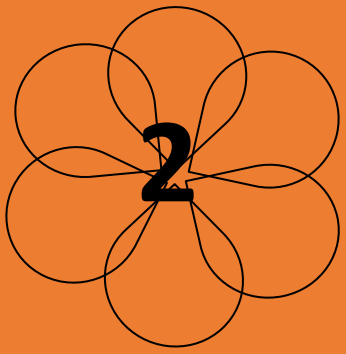
Aims for the **ALLEMED**-workshop

The workshop's goals are:

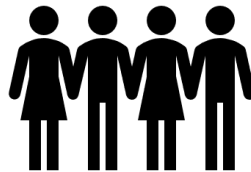
- Become more aware of how our activities can become more inclusive.

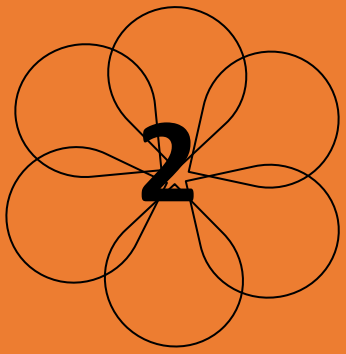


Can we identify a specific incident involving a child who faced exclusion that we managed to include after all? How did we do it?



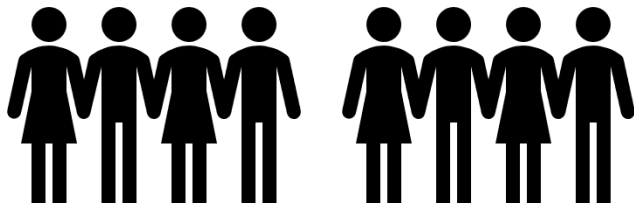

2. Discuss the questions on the selected cards – write down concrete suggestions

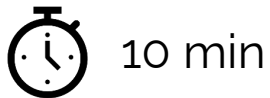
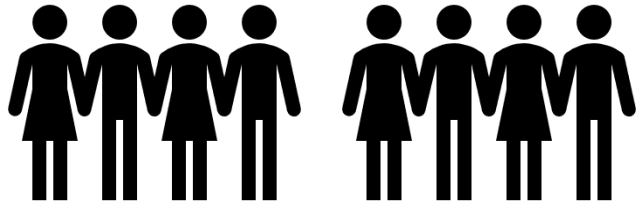

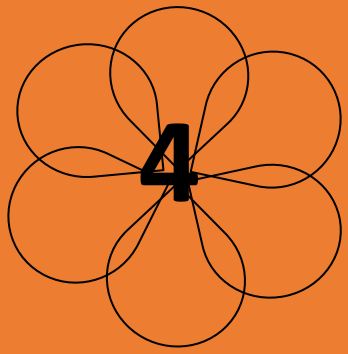
Each group discuss **solutions and ideas** how all children and youth will get the possibility to participate in leisure activities, regardless of the financial situation of their families
