

#### **Look Back:**

• Did you come to discover a pattern of brokenness in your life? How did you invite Jesus to help?

### **Connect:**

• Share a time when you invested time and energy into restoring, or fixing something that was in disrepair - furniture, home, vehicle, relationships...

### **Look Up:**

#### Read: Jeremiah 29:10-13 and Isaiah 55:8-9

- What additional insights are provided when we read the verses before and after Jeremiah 29:11?
- How does the fact that God knows more about your future than you do, make you feel?
  What impact might this have on your journey of restoration?
- What does Jeremiah 29:13 say is the key to gaining clarity regarding the future plans that God has for us? How successful have you been at doing this and how can this group help you?
- Do the verses from Isaiah challenge or encourage you? Why?

#### Read: 2 Corinthians 4:16-18

- How important is it to have a "vision" of the future state when you are trying to restore something? How should we apply this when we are restoring our soul?
- What do you think Paul means when he talks about inwardly being renewed day by day?
  How do you think this was happening and how can we apply it?
- Why do you think Paul mentions "troubles" in verse 17? Why is this important to Christians today?

#### **Overall (Discovery Bible Study)**

- What do these scriptures say about God?
- What do they say about people?
- How will I apply this to my life?

#### Look Ahead:

• We all need restoration in one way or another. As we close this series, what's one area, you want to actively pursue restoration? What is one step you will commit to doing?
