6. What does Jesus say was His purpose in life in these verses? How did the Jews respond? How do you personally react and respond to these verses and why?

7. What is the 1st thing Jesus did when He took the bread and the cup? How should people today apply this in their daily lives?

Notes

Too often we tend to focus more on our circumstances rather than God's promises and provision. God miraculously led the nation of Israel into the desert and miraculously provided for them in the desert, despite their complaining and desire to turn away from God. God gave the Israelites manna in the wilderness to remind them that He was their eternal provider. Jesus came to complete God's promise and connects God's short-term provision in the wilderness to God's eternal provision. His offer is to all people and is still available today.
