Global Composite Risk Index: Methodology

The Global Composite Risk Index measures a full spectrum of country risks using aggregated data from organizations and think tanks around the world. RANE identifies, analyzes, and curates information from a wide array of sources to equip professionals not only with insights, but with the data behind those insights. This way companies can better evaluate risk, while also having defensible documentation for their standards of care.

For a source to be included in a risk category calculation, the underlying data must be quantitative, incorporate a minimum and maximum score, and have a rigorous and transparent methodology. Additionally, the data and scope of each source must align with the RANE-defined descriptive lens for each risk category. In general, these sources release new data annually or every other year. Therefore, the Global Composite Risk Index is a lagging indicator of risk. For users wanting a forward-looking view of risk, see the complimentary Geopolitical Outlook and Security Outlook.

RANE uses a proprietary tool and methodology to aggregate the data and normalize the scores for all sources included in the Global Composite Risk Index. Once normalized, the scale for risk is zero to 100, with zero representing the least risk and 100
