The Bishop has appointed Father Anthony Grant as Assistant Priest to St Margaret's. Fr Antony will be ordained to the Priesthood on the 23rd of July in St Anthony's Forest Gate. Fr Anthony is a local and has lived most of his life in Forest Gate, and he attended St Bonaventure's. He is a late vocation and studied at the Beda College in Rome. Confirmation: I will be inviting the young people who wish to be confirmed to a meeting that will take place in the Autumn. This will be the first part of our preparation for the confirmation that will take place in 2022. I shall be holding a retreat day and all who wish to be confirmed will be invited. **Hospital Visits:** If you go into hospital or a member of your family, inform the Parish Office so that the priest can visit you in hospital.

Visits to the Sick and Housebound: Over the next few weeks, I shall be visiting all of the sick and housebound in the Parish. Can I ask the Eucharistic Ministers who normally visit the sick and housebound with Holy Communion if you have restarted your visits.

Gift Aid: A number of issued Gift Aid envelopes remain uncollected. Please call into the parish office to pick up yours and discard the old ones. Anyone new to the parish who is a tax payer and wishes to join the Gift Aid scheme should ask for a Declaration form – you will be notified as soon as the envelopes are ready. Please do not use envelopes from other parishes. For every £ you put in the offertory we are able to claim back 25p from the tax man at no cost to yourselves. This is a valuable source of income for our parish. Thank you for your continued generosity.
