Qualified candidates

- Must be a fully initiated Catholic in the communion of the Catholic Church and intentionally living out the five precepts of the Church (CCC 2041-2043);
- Refrain from the public promotion or approval of, or the living out of, any conduct or lifestyle that would reflect discredit or disgrace on, or cause scandal in relationship to, the Archdiocese of Denver, or considered to be in contradiction with Catholic doctrine or morals;
 - Possess a master's degree with a minimum of 20 graduate hours in supervision, curriculum, instruction, or other related fields;
 - Have a minimum of five (5) years teaching or administrative experience in Catholic schools;
 - Hold a current, valid administrator's license certificate or become certified by the State of Colorado* as a principal.

In addition, the principal is expected to adhere to the minimum requirements for Catechist Certification as set forth by the Archdiocese of Denver. * Principals in the Archdiocese of Denver who do not hold a current, valid administrator's license/certificate must complete the requirements for a Colorado Administrator's License within three years from the date they first become a principal.
