Ferry Timetable

Following the announcement by the Queensland Premier this morning confirming a three day lock down of Greater Brisbane, we can confirm that RiverCity Ferries is considered an essential public transport service and will continue to operate.

The service will continue as scheduled over the weekend, transporting essential workers, and members of the community who need to use the service for essential reasons.

Due to the impact of restrictions on staffing levels, on Monday 11 January, the SpeedyCat Service will not operate.

We have strict on board COVIDSafe practices, and ask customers to adhere to social distancing practices while onboard, where possible. A reminder that Queensland Health advises that masks are now mandatory and must be worn outside your home, which includes on public transport.
