



**3K Preschool Welcome Letter
Ages 36 Months – 47 Months**



We would like to welcome you and thank you for allowing us to provide quality care for your child. In this stage of your child's life we will continue to reinforce and review ideas and concepts that we have been focusing on.

They include:

Counting and recognizing their numbers- 1 - 25

Recognizing their name

Learning their Phone Number

Reciting and recognizing ABC's

Recognizing colors and shapes

Nutrition and health

Music and Movement

Beginning writing skills (hold pencil and crayon)

Social Skills (sharing, getting along with others, conflict resolution, field trips etc.)

Self-help Skills (proper toileting habits, washing hands, putting on and off coats, eating with proper utensils, and clean up time).

We will have daily story time to enhance your child's listening skills. We will focus on following directions and the class rules. Centers are provided so that the children can learn through play and express themselves through interaction with each other throughout the day.

We will have outside time weather permitting, if we are unable to go outside, the children will have play time in the gym area. Please dress your child in weather appropriate clothing and clothing you don't mind getting dirty and soiled with markers and paint.

We also do field trips in this class and invite you to share with us by volunteering as a chaperone. The teachers are always looking for volunteers to assist in the class please fill free to

discuss with them any role you may want to be involved in. Field trip permission forms will be distributed before the scheduled trip. They must be completed and returned before your child can leave the Academy.

Medicine

Medicine forms are located in the classroom. The form must be filled out completely before we can administer any medication. Medication need to be in the original container before we can administer it. This is a DSS regulation. If needed, please fill out and give it and medication to the teacher or director.

What your child needs:

Box of tissue

Small bottle of Anti-bacterial soap

Blanket (which is taken home every Friday to be cleaned)

Two changes of seasonal clothing including socks

Please be sure to check your child's cubby daily for soiled clothing or notes from the teacher.

Please do not dress your child in belts and clothing that is hard for them to remove during potty time.

We want your child to enjoy their classroom experience. We are with your child during the most active time of the day and we would like to partner with you. Together we can work as a team to make their daily learning experiences fun, as well as educational. We have an open door policy here so please feel free to drop in anytime.
