Preserve free and open access from the West Steps of the Capitol to the West End of Capitol Mall.

Stop the billion-dollar demolition and new Annex expansion Project.

Restore the historic Capitol Annex and utilize the “Swing” Building for additional office space for a less costly, permanent solution.

Since restoration would not exceed the footprint of the existing Annex, this alternative would not disturb the sacred ground and ancestral artifacts of Tribal Communities.

This alternative would protect and preserve all of the sacred trees in Capitol Park.
