The **Family Reconciliation Program** uses Circles to enable families, caseworkers and other professionals to talk to each other in a good way about the safety and well-being of children. Impartial NCSA Circle Facilitators ensure everyone is heard and guide respectful, caring, and honest conversation. The Circle's focus on the needs of children and connecting them to family, culture, and community.

Currently, our Family Reconciliation program is looking for the right candidate to fill a Full-Time, 1-year contract (with possibility of extension) as our Circle Facilitator.

Specific responsibilities of the position include:

- Organize and facilitate circles for the safety and well-being of children.
- To build resiliency of children and families to reconcile the impacts of colonialism and historic trauma.
- To ensure program requirements are met in accordance with contractual agreements with Native Counselling Services of Alberta and Funders.

Our ideal candidate would have the following qualifications:

- **In-depth experience and working knowledge of Indigenous communities, cultures, healing and language.**
- Demonstrated understanding of historic trauma and the impact of colonization on Indigenous people.
- Degree, diploma or certificate in Human Services with previous supervisory experience and/or coaching and program development.
- Understanding of the operation of service systems within the housing sector, Alberta Works and income support, justice and community services is an asset.
- Good working knowledge of computers and Microsoft 365.
- Ability to seek out and build relationships with individuals, families, team members and community partners.
- Must have a reliable vehicle, valid Alberta driver's license with required liability insurance and confirmation of insurance coverage to transport clients.
- Must provide a completed a criminal record check, child intervention check and may be required to pass a provincial or federal government security clearance.
