EXPLANATION OF SERVICES, FACILITIES, VEHICLES AND SUPPLIES

Professional and Staff Services

Coordinating activities, rites and ceremonies: Basic services include professional consultation with licensed personnel, 24-hour per day on-call staff, coordinating with the hospital or other place of death, collection of vital statistics information, as well as administration, accounting and ongoing record keeping related to the selected arrangements. Services may include, but is not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs, essential services and legislation relating to disposition, documentation, assisting with drafting notices and applications for possible government benefits.

In addition to basic services, the coordination of all rites and ceremonies may include the planning and scheduling of services, facilities and staff for all arranged events, including any required or requested services, supplies, vehicles and equipment supplied by us, or provided by third party suppliers. This may also include, but is not limited to, arranging outside facilities and services such as clergy, musicians, cemeteries, monuments, vaults, churches, halls, flowers, catering, custom printing, and notices.

Documentation: Completion and filing of all documents and forms necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested. This may include, but is not limited to, death registration, burial permit, cremation application, Coroner's Certificate for cremation, and documentation necessary to ship the body in or out of the province or country. As part of this service, we will assist with CPP applications when appropriate, and provide Proof of Death Certificates issued by Steckley-Gooderham Funeral Home, which are accepted for most estate settlement purposes. Occasionally a "Death Certificate" from the Office of the Registrar General will be necessary.

Staff for Transfer of Remains: (requires Transfer vehicle)

Professionally trained staff members as required to bring the deceased into our care or to an alternate location as determined by a doctor or coroner.

Basic preparation of remains: (requires Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter)

The preparation of the deceased for placement into the casket by professionally trained staff employing protective equipment, for the purpose of identification and/or disposition. Includes any necessary cleansing or disinfecting, as well as searching remains for personal effects, and the utilization of a body pouch where necessary. This charge applies whenever we handle a deceased individual or remains.

Embalming of remains: (requires Facilities for preparation/embalming/ shelter)

The preparation of the body for identification or private viewing without embalming, including cleansing, dressing, the setting of facial features, and placement into casket.

Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and the expected service needs.

Staff services for visitation: Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation (informal gathering time) including, but not limited to, the arrangement of flowers, pictures and mementos in the visitation suite, greeting and directing guests, supervision of parking, collecting memorial donations, and the provision of lounge services when on our premises. Visitation period of a maximum of two hours.

If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.

On-line Video and Live Streaming: Live streaming refers to video and/or audio content being delivered in real-time, as events happen. Live streaming requires a video camera, an audio interface, screen capture software, an encoder to digitize the content, a media publisher, and a content delivery provider to distribute and deliver the content. We are proud to be able to offer live streaming on our own channel through Ustream. Live streaming does not need to be recorded although it frequently is.

Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by the funeral home. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. If disbursements are on our contract, they may be subject to HST. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements:

Coroner's fee: This is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Municipal death registration fee: This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

Clergy/Celebrant/church/organist honourarium: This is an amount paid to the clergy/church/organist for their services. In some cases, the amount is set by the clergy and in others it is an amount you wish to offer.

Newspaper or radio notices: These are charges for death notices or other media outlets.
