## **EXPLANATION OF SERVICES, FACILITIES, VEHICLES AND SUPPLIES**

### **Professional and Staff Services**

**Arranging, administration, and coordination:** Basic services include professional consultation with licensed personnel, 24-hour per day on-call staff, coordination with the hospital or other place of death, communication with doctors, coroners, and emergency personnel as required, as well as all administration, accounting and ongoing record keeping related to the selected arrangements. Services include expert advice on options to meet your needs including, but not limited to, essential services and legislation relating to disposition, documentation, assisting with drafting notices, and applications for possible government benefits.

In addition to the basic services, coordination of all activities, rites and ceremonies may include the planning and scheduling of services, arranging facilities and staff for requested events, including any necessary services, supplies, vehicles and equipment supplied by us or provided by third party suppliers. This may also include, but is not limited to, arranging outside facilities and services such as clergy, musicians, cemeteries, monuments, vaults, churches, halls, flowers, catering, custom printing, and notices.

**Documentation and Aftercare:** Collection of vital statistics information, as well as the completion and filing of all documents and forms necessary to carry out the services requested. This may include, but is not limited to, death registration, burial permit, cremation application, Coroner's Certificate for cremation, and documentation to transport the body in or out of the province or country.

Estate settlement assistance may include, but is not limited to, cancellation of CPP/OAS, applications for the CPP Death Benefit, Survivor's Pension, and Children's Benefits, cancellation of Health Card and SIN, and review of additional checklist items which may pertain. Includes Proof of Death Certificates issued by Steckley-Gooderham Funeral Home, which are accepted for most estate settlement purposes. Occasionally a "Death Certificate" from the Office of the Registrar General will be necessary.

**Staff for Transfer of Remains:** (requires transfer vehicle)

Professionally trained staff members as required to bring the deceased into our care or to an alternate location as determined by a doctor or coroner.

**\$350.00**

**Basic preparation of remains:** The preparation of the deceased for placement into the casket by professionally trained staff employing protective equipment, for the purpose of identification and/or disposition. Includes any necessary cleansing or disinfecting, as well as searching remains for personal effects, and the utilization of a body pouch where necessary. This charge applies whenever we handle a deceased individual or remains and may also involve the preparation of the body for identification or private viewing (without embalming), including dressing, setting of facial features, and placement into casket.

**Embalming of remains:** Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and the expected service needs.

**Staff services for visitation:** Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation (informal gathering time) including, but not limited to, the arrangement of flowers, pictures and mementos in the visitation suite, greeting and directing guests, supervision of parking, collecting memorial donations, cleaning and resetting of facilities, and the provision of lounge services when on our premises. Each visitation period includes of a maximum of two hours.

### **Disbursements**

**Coroner's fee:** This is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

**Municipal death registration fee:** This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

**Newspaper or radio notices:** These are charges for death notices or other media outlets.
