Pastor: Will you pray for her help and honor her for her work's sake, and in all things strive to live together in the peace and unity of Christ?

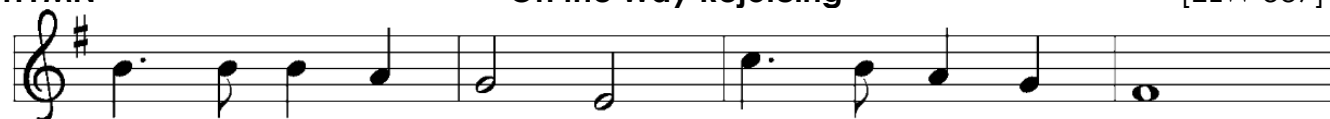

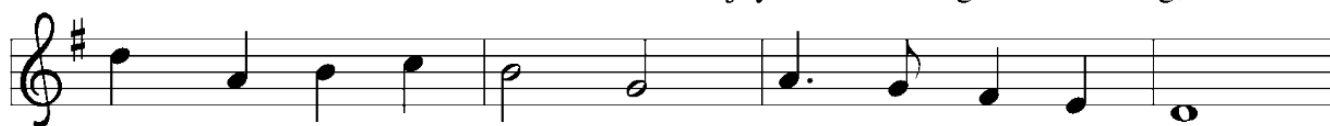
