## **FREQUENCY**

Meetings are scheduled for the second Wednesday of every other month at 5p ET, with the possibility of modifications based on demand. Our 2023 schedule:

While we are discussing clinical cases, research scientists who are studying osteosarcoma are also welcome to attend and listen to the discussion to get a sense of real-life clinical challenges and applications.

### **PLATFORM**

Cases are reviewed on the OncoLens platform. TURBO meetings are conducted virtually over Zoom.

- 3-4 cases will be discussed in each tumor board meeting.
- Matteo Trucco, MD, a pediatric oncologist at Cleveland Clinic, is the TURBO moderator and he will introduce each presenter and share the case information in the OncoLens platform via Zoom.

- Please try to make the call from a private/quiet location for your own comfort and those on the call. Background noise tends to be magnified on these calls.
- Please mute your phone/computer when not speaking to eliminate background noise.

### **GUIDELINES FOR ALL PRESENTERS**

- If you are interested in submitting a case to TURBO, please complete the <u>inquiry form</u> on the MIB Agents website or email <u>christina@mibagents.org</u>
- Once MIB Agents receives your inquiry, you will receive a case submission template.
- Please send your case submission slides to <u>christina@mibagents.org</u> by 5p ET
   Wednesday, one week prior to the tumor board.
- Please try to make the call from a private/quiet location for your own comfort and those on the call. Background noise tends to be magnified on these calls.
- Please be prepared to join the meeting 5 minutes before the meeting starts. This will allow us to determine presentation order based on presenter time restrictions and schedules.
- Limit presentation to 5-7 minutes to allow adequate time for group discussion
- Have a focused question or questions for the group to discuss
- Even though there will often be radiology and pathology specialists with expertise in
  osteosarcoma on the call, presenters <u>must</u> supply their own radiologist and
  pathologist for review of the material, if applicable (its use is left up to the discretion of
  the presenter)
- All submitted materials **must** be HIPAA-compliant. Please remove all Protected Health Information (PHI) from all materials, including images.
- If you would like to share any images, static images work best. You may include images in the template or submit them separately as jpg, png, or pdf files.
- Literature review of the relevant question(s) is encouraged but a general background review on osteosarcoma is not necessary



# **FEEDBACK**

- A summation of the tumor board consensus recommendations from the meeting will be provided to the presenter within 2 days of the call.
- MIB Agents will follow up with presenters to track outcomes post tumor board. A short survey (2 questions) will be sent 1 week and 6 months after the tumor board meeting.
