

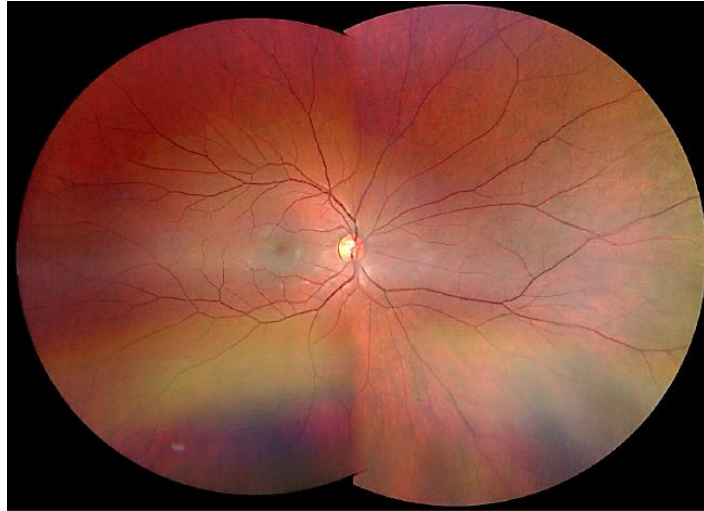
RETINAL HEALTH IMAGING CONSENT

These images give the doctor a detailed eye health picture. We recommend this imaging to monitor for diseases such as high blood pressure, diabetes, glaucoma, and macular degeneration. Your photos will become part of your permanent medical record and monitored each year for progression. In many cases, this may be used instead of dilated examination.

How often should I get this imaging done?

We advise that every patient get imaging at their first exam. Getting it done annually allows for the most thorough exam. At minimum, we advise that patients 39 and younger get it every 3rd year, and patients 40 and older get it every other year. If you have certain medical/eye history, we may have to dilate you.
