
The Grove: Updates








- Making a rental plan: We are excited about a continued interest in rental requests and activities at The Grove! Unfortunately, without having staff at the building full-time, facility access is challenging. Our team hopes to establish and implement this new system in January 2023 for Spring activities and Fall 2023 reservations.
- Civil Designs are coming along! Wyser Engineering (our civil engineer) presented their first preliminary design for parking and sidewalk advancements at The Grove based on the drawings recommended this summer. We are now focusing on the wetland and soil reviews due to our closeness to the creek. BGW just shared their new entry site plan concept to be utilized in our next design update!



- Financing Applications: Our Finance Team has begun the loan application
 process for several potential lenders to assist in completing the financing for The
 Grove! This month, Henry Elling also completed our WEDC grant application--we
 hope to hear back from them in the following weeks regarding this \$250,000
 grant.
- **BGW came to town--a shift in plans!** Check out the most recent design recommended from the BGW and NCI onsite visit! A larger copy is also posted in the gathering space. We are in the process of establishing the new cost estimate-contractors are confident it will be equal to or slightly under the previous plan's budget. We hope to move forward with confidence in this new direction! This shift in design includes:
 - Leaving the kitchen
 - New, centrally-located and inviting entrance
 - Shifted office shape for staff and volunteers
 - Moving community meeting rooms to the main hall
 - Intentional Youth Room space

 engagement event at The Grove could look like! While we don't anticipate it
 happening before the new year, stay tuned on ways to get involved and future


