

#### **Constitution Bylaw Change Update:**

In the annual giving letter, we notified you of a proposed bylaw change to be voted on at the annual meeting. Upon further review, the recommended "constitutional bylaw amendment," should be listed as a "new bylaw" *under* **C13.02** (Nominating Committee Constitutional Provision). Voting will still occur at the annual meeting:

#### **Current Constitutional Provision:**

**C13.02** A *nominating committee* of six voting members of this congregation, two of whom, if possible, shall be outgoing members of the Congregational Council, shall be elected at the annual meeting for a term of one year. Members of the Nominating Committee are not eligible for consecutive reelection.

#### **Proposed New Bylaw:**

**C13.02.01** A confirmed youth in 10th or 11th grade may be added as a seventh member of the nominating committee.
