RESIDENTIAL INGROUND SWIMMING POOL **\$200.00**

As per the **State of Louisiana** *only* Contractors holding one or more of the license classifications below are legally eligible to build or repair swimming pools for homes, when the pool contract, including the cost of all labor and materials, exceeds \$7500.

Commercial contractor's license with the following classification(s):

- *Building Construction, and/or*
- *Swimming Pools, and/or*
- *Swimming Pools, Water Features and Fountains*

Residential building contractor's license with the following classification:

- *Residential Swimming Pools*

NOTE: **Additional time will be necessary for a complete Plan Review to be performed.**

SPECIAL NOTE: If site is in a Special Flood Hazard Area, all mechanical equipment that is attached to dwelling must be at floor level of dwelling. If mechanical equipment is separate from dwelling, it will have to be at the proper Base Flood Elevation and will require an Elevation Certificate to show mechanicals meet elevation requirements.
