Guidelines for Senior Privileges

- 1) Seniors who have a composite 2.00 grade point average at the start of the year would be granted senior privileges at the beginning of the school year.
- 2) Seniors who do not have a composite 2.00 grade point average at the start of the year would be granted senior privileges at the start of the second nine week grading period if they earned a 2.00 grade point average during the first nine weeks.
- 3) A student must maintain at least a 2.00 grade point average for each nine week grading period in order to maintain his/her privileges for the next nine week grading period.
- 4) Seniors would be able to leave the building during their study hall periods and lunch hours. Seniors would not be required to check into study hall, but they will be required to leave the building within the normal five minute passing time.
- 5) A student must be doing passing work in all of his/her subjects. If a student is denied senior privileges due to grades, those privileges can be reinstated as soon as he/she has brought up the grades to passing.
- 6) After a senior has accumulated two tardies, each subsequent tardy will result in a one week revocation of privileges.
- 7) Seniors would be able to wear regular clothing during the last week they are in school. However, clothes should be appropriate for school.

Also at this time, we would like to remind you that the Aberdeen Catholic School Board has abolished senior skip day. Any senior who participates in any form of a senior skip day will not participate in the graduation ceremony nor receive a diploma. We ask for your cooperation and understanding in this matter.
