008.5 Excused or Reduced Tuition

Aberdeen Catholic School Board of Education is committed to the principle that no child will ever be refused attendance at Aberdeen Catholic Schools because of inability to pay tuition. Student jobs are available and reduction of tuition is granted by the Board for those who simply do not have the means.

If a family cannot afford to pay tuition several options are available.

- a) Students may apply for a tuition work-contract.
- b) Families may apply for financial assistance to obtain a reduction in tuition.
- c) Fill out Family Financial Information Form which includes a copy of the W-2.
- d) They will be evaluated by the Financial Assistance Committee of the Aberdeen Catholic School System.
- e) Send the forms to the Aberdeen Catholic School Central Office, 1400 N. Dakota Street.
- f) Families may sign a promissory note for tuition to be paid in the future when family expenses are not as demanding.
