- Reminder that the October 26 volleyball game vs Miller will be at Presentation Strode Arena. They will keep the concessions; we will keep the gate.
- Administration was asked to thank the Cavalry for the Teacher meal we provided for parent teacher conferences.
- Many Parents also thanked the Cavalry for the "freebee's" given for Parents Night.
