To parents, caregivers and staff:

Federal laws written in 1980, 1984 and 1986 required that all schools public and private conduct a survey for asbestos in building materials. Included in these laws were requirements to have a management plan on hand for public review, a designated person on hand, and periodic inspections.

Steve Rowland is the designated person who has completed the 16-hour Asbestos Operations and Maintenance (class three) course. The initial training was completed at TSI in Cleveland, Ohio, on 3/20/2012, and a 4-hour refresher course has been completed each year.

The designated person performs a visual inspection of any remaining suspected asbestos containing building materials every 6 months and schedules a 3-year re-inspection by a state licensed inspector. The last 3-year inspection was performed on 11/29/2018 by Brumbaugh-Herrick, Inc. and was satisfactory.
