



## Queen and Wardoo Street intersection works

From 6:30pm Friday to 5:00am Monday on the weekends of

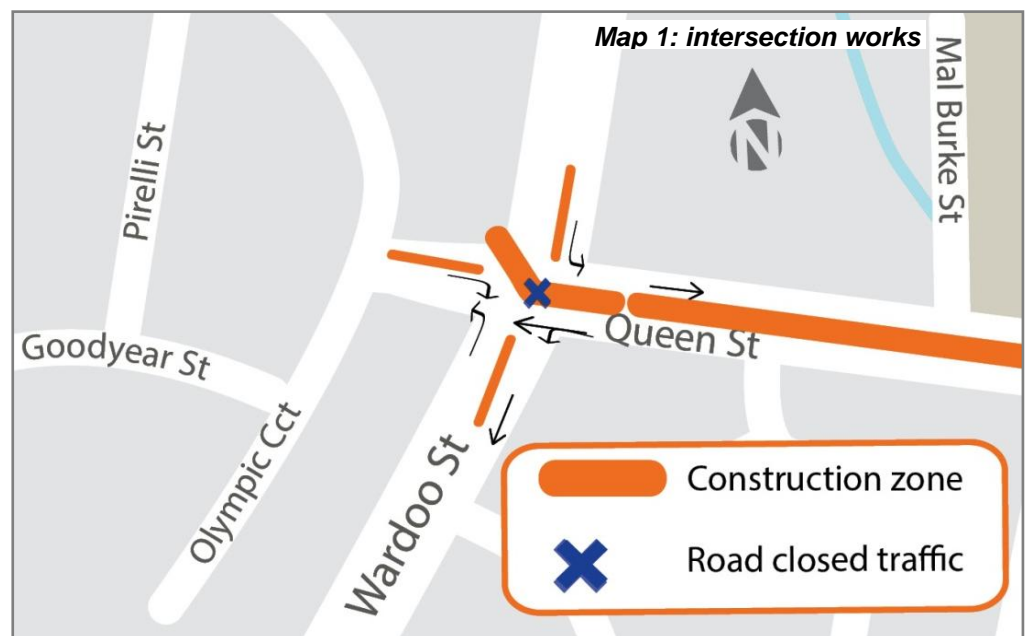
- Friday 18 January to Monday 21 January
- Friday 01 February to Monday 04 February 2013

The intersection of Queen and Wardoo Street, Southport, will be partially closed to prepare for and lay light rail track.

Construction crews will work around the clock to prepare the intersection for tracklaying during the quieter weekend traffic period.

### Traffic changes:

- Partial closure of the intersection of Queen and Wardoo Streets (see map 1).
- Wardoo Street will be closed to through traffic in both directions with only left turns maintained. Motorists will need to detour via Queen Street, Southport-Nerang Road and the Smith Street Motorway (see map 2 overleaf).
- No right turn at Wardoo Street from Queen Street.
- No right turn from Wardoo Street into Firestone Street.
- Motorists will be able to access Firestone Street and Olympic Circuit via Queen Street westbound and Wardoo Street northbound. Right turn only from Firestone Street.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area.



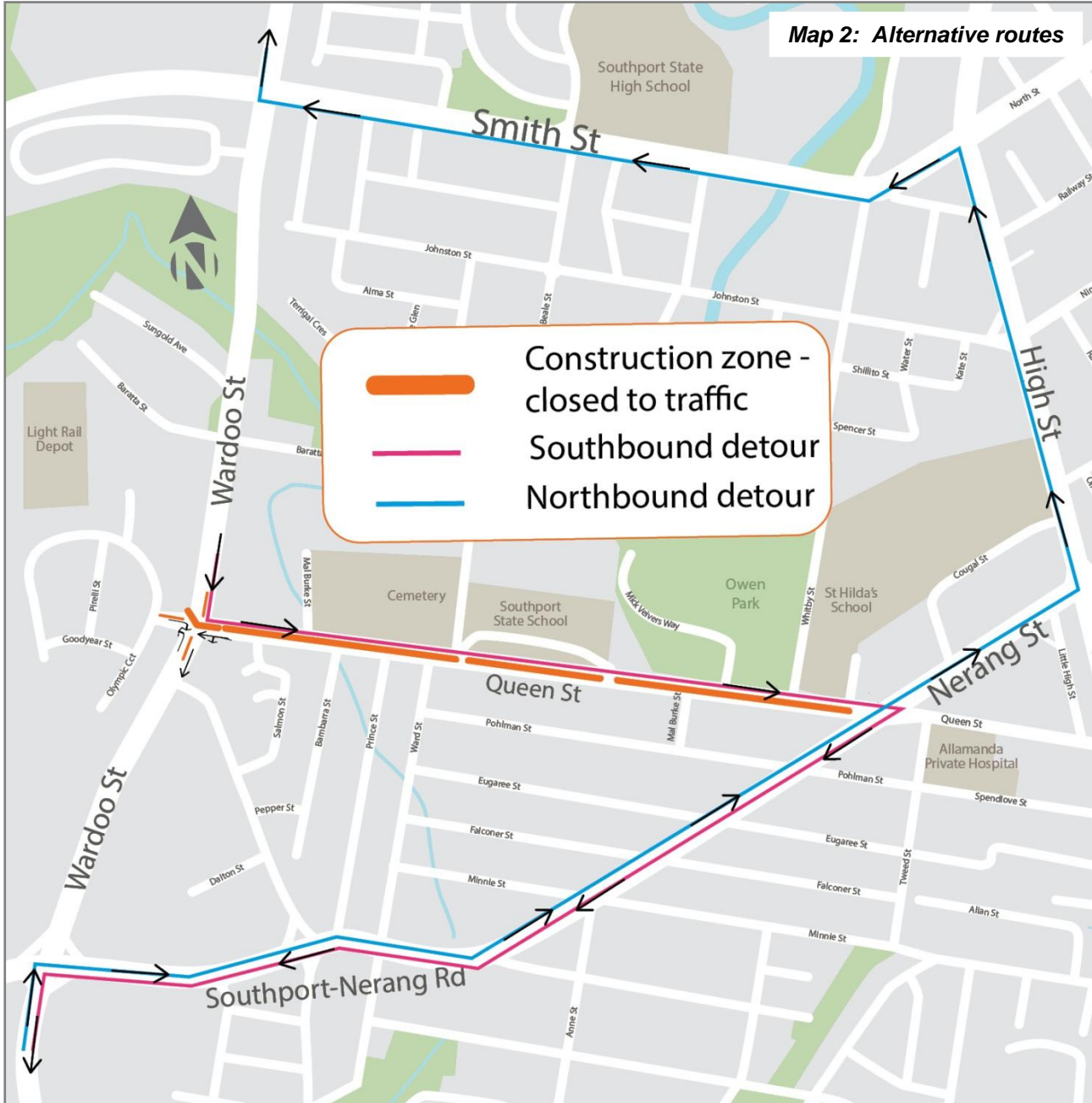
### What to expect:

- Construction crews will work from 6:30pm Friday to 5:00am Monday on the designated weekends to ensure the intersection is re-opened to motorists by 6:00am.
- Construction will include excavation, installation of underground services, track laying and concrete pours.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
