

# **Parking in Southport**

### Free parking

Council is trialing free parking in Southport on weekends between 29 September and 11 November 2012. Two hour parking time limits will still apply.

#### Parking removed

From 2 October the centre parking in Nerang Street, between Davenport and High Streets will be removed to allow track form construction to begin.

#### **New parking**


55 new spaces will be available at a new car park in Queen Street near Scarborough Street in October, from \$1 per hour.

#### Commercial parking

There are three commercial car parks in Nerang Street near Rawlins Street and two in Scarborough Street near White Street. They generally charge \$2 per hour to a maximum of \$6. Some have a discounted evening rate.

There is also parking under the

Southport Central complex (entry from Lawson Street) and in the TAFE building (entry from Scarborough Street).

#### Side streets and parking zones

There is two hour parking in nearby side streets including White, Garden, Lawson, and Short Streets as well as additional 15 minute zones in Owens Lane next to the Bendigo Bank and in White Street.

### **Council parking stations**

Athol Paterson car park in Lawson Street (next to the library car park) holds 183 cars. Mal Bourke car park in Hinze Street, near the Court House, which holds 323 cars. Carey Park near Marine Parade, which holds 360 cars. Fees range from \$1.20 to \$1.40 per hour.
