



Queen Street median closures

From Monday 24 September 2012, GoldLinQ will progress with rail preparation works along Queen Street. For safety, the entry and exit through the centre median area outside Southport State School on the first week of the school holidays will be closed (see Fig.1 below). In the second week access will be reinstated and the median opposite Mick Veivers Way will be closed (see Fig. 2 below).

Traffic changes:

- Closure of centre median entry and exit points to Southport State School during school holidays.
- Closure of centre median opposite Mick Veivers Way from 29 September until 5 October 2012. Left turn entry and exit only.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Temporary lane closures during night works for rail delivery.
- Traffic management measures such as traffic control and signage will be in place.

What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

Night works:

- Night works will be required as part of these works to minimise the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
