



## Parklands Drive Precinct Update

From Thursday night 13 September to Monday night 18 September 2012 GoldlinQ will complete asphaltting works outside Parklands Gold Coast along Parklands Drive, weather permitting.

### Traffic changes:

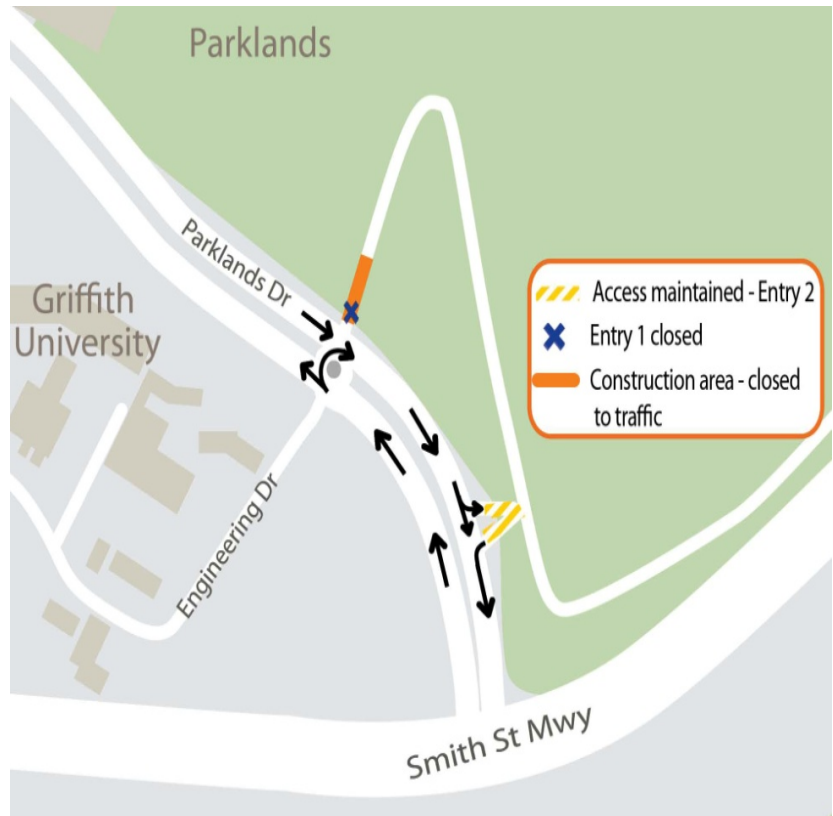
- Entry 1 to Parklands Gold Coast will be closed with all traffic directed to Entry 2.
- Entry and exit to Parklands Gold Coast will be via left turn only.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained and directed from Entry 2 of Parklands Gold Coast.
- Motorists from Smith Street Motorway are to drive around the Engineering Drive roundabout and down to Entry 2.
- Motorists from Olsen Avenue are to drive through the Engineering Drive roundabout and turn left into Entry 2.

### What to expect:

- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:00am and 6:00pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Heavy and minor machinery noise including reversing alarms from 6.30am. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Installation of safety fencing and traffic barriers to contain the work area.
- Asphalt, kerb, footpath and landscaping reinstatement.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

### Night works:

- Night works may be required as part of these works to minimise the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- Night work will be carried out between 6.30pm and 6.30am, Sunday to Thursday.
