Construction Notice

Traffic diversions at Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway)

From Tuesday 11 September 2012, major construction for the light rail at the intersection of Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) and Surfers Paradise Boulevard will halt in preparation for the Armor All Gold Coast 600.

Some ongoing works, predominantly in the construction area at Jarriparilla Cove adjacent to the Marriott Resort, will occur.

At this time, the Armor All Gold Coast 600 team will take responsibility for traffic flow in the area and will be implementing traffic diversions for the event. The Gold Coast 600 team will notify you directly about any traffic switches which may affect you.



Traffic changes:

Prior to the set-up for the Armor All Gold Coast 600, GoldLinQ will implement the following traffic changes (see map).

- The Gold Coast Highway will reopen to all southbound traffic from the intersection at Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) to Ocean Avenue.
- Temporary median installation along the Gold Coast Highway to facilitate traffic diversions.
- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will remain southbound only from the intersection of Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) and Surfers Paradise Boulevard.
- Ocean Avenue will also remain one-way only with priority movements onto the Gold Coast Highway southbound.
- Access onto the Gold Coast Highway northbound from Ocean Avenue will be removed.
- Please drive to the conditions at all times.

Night works:

- Night works will be required for traffic management from Monday 10 September 7:00pm to Tuesday 11 September 6:30am.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) reversing alarms rather than beepers to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.

What to expect:

- Safety fencing to contain GoldLinQ's active work areas.
- Ongoing construction at Jarriparilla Cove involves relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements, to facilitate construction activities.
- Temporary footpath closures near the area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
