



Changed conditions and night works in Scarborough and Nerang Streets

From Sunday 29 July 2012, there will be changes to parking, traffic and pedestrian access in Scarborough Street, between Hicks and Lawson Streets, and Nerang Street, between Davenport and Scarborough Streets.

This work will involve extensive night works to minimise inconvenience to businesses, pedestrians and traffic.



Traffic changes:

- On street angle parking in Scarborough Street and centre parking in Nerang Street, between Davenport and Scarborough Streets, will be permanently removed.
- The pedestrian crossing across Nerang Street, running between Dick Smith and the Cecil Hotel, will be closed for several months during construction. Alternative pedestrian access will be signed.
- On Monday 30 July the bus stops in Scarborough Street outside the police station and TAFE building will be closed while new bus stops are being built. Alternative bus stops are located outside Australia Fair.

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Night works:

- Ongoing night works will be required as part of these works to minimise the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic.
- Underground services works between 7:00pm and 5:30am, Sunday to Thursday.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.

What to expect during construction:

- Traffic lanes in Scarborough and Nerang Street will be realigned (see map overleaf).
- Two way traffic and driveway access will be maintained (see map overleaf). Alternative routes and redirections will be signed.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction will involve relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- The speed limit will be reduced to 40 km/h in the work zone.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
