



Works in Nerang and Scarborough Streets

As part of Queensland's first light rail construction, works will start in Nerang and Scarborough Streets in Southport from late May 2012. Construction will involve relocating underground services such as gas and water, upgrading storm water drainage, landscaping, track form works to lay the rail, building light rail stations and landscaping.

What to expect:

- Removal of centre parking in Scarborough Street, between Hinze and Hicks Streets.
- Vegetation clearing along Nerang and Scarborough Streets.
- Removal of the bicycle lane in the work area.
- Changes in pedestrian movements at the corner of Nerang and Scarborough streets.
- Construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday. Affected businesses and residents will be notified of works outside those times.



Parking arrangements and traffic changes during construction

Changes to parking:

- The progressive and permanent removal of on-street parking in Scarborough Street, between Hinze and Lawson Streets, and Nerang Street, between Davenport and Scarborough Streets.

Taxi rank relocation:

- The existing taxi rank in Scarborough Street will be relocated 100 metres north to the Nerang Street mall.

Changed traffic conditions:

- Traffic will be maintained in Scarborough Street during these works.
- For safety reasons the speed limit will be reduced to 40 km/hr.
- Traffic management and directional signage will be in place to direct motorists and pedestrians.
- Access to shops and businesses will be open at all times but the points of access may change.
