



Gold Coast Light Rail

Week Commencing Monday 13 May 2013



Parklands

Track form work along Parklands Drive and within the underground station continues.

Depot

Track form work within the Depot and towards Wardoo Street continues. Work on the administration building includes installation of interior walls, ceilings and drainage.

Southport

Queen Street

Between Wardoo and Nerang Streets

Installation of overhead line poles and preparation work for station construction work continues. There will be night time lane closures in both directions to complete kerbing and pavement works. Local access will be maintained. Night time delivery of structural steel for Queen Street station will also occur.

Nerang Street

Installation of overhead line poles continues.

Between Queen and Davenport Streets

Track preparation including concrete pours, rail delivery and kerb work continue. There will be occasional night time lane closures for this work.

Between Davenport and Scarborough Streets

Preparation continues for station construction.

Scarborough Street

Scarborough Street Traffic Changes

Work will move to the eastern side of Scarborough Street for kerb and pavement work, drainage installation and preparation for track laying. These works will take approximately eight weeks to complete. Some driveway entry points have changed. Please follow traffic controllers and signage.

Between Nerang Street and Australia Fair

Drainage work continues. Some of this work will be completed at night.

Between Lawson Street and White Street.

Drainage and kerb works continue. Construction of the new bus stop will also progress.

Between White and Queen Streets

Track laying and concrete pours will occur in the centre median with some night time lane closures required. Works building an Energex pit on the western footpath will finish this week.

Between Short Street and Australia Fair

Kerb laying will continue.

Between Short Street and Park Lane

Water main works continue opposite the RSL.

Between Westpac and Queen Street

Kerbing and asphalt works will occur.

Young Street

Young Street will reopen to traffic in both directions.

Lawson Street

Kerb laying and excavation work for storm water drainage continues. Lawson Street will be closed for several weeks. Traffic will be maintained in both directions on Scarborough Street.

Short Street

All access to Short Street will be via Marine Parade while stormwater pipes are installed. Short Street will reopen to through traffic at the Scarborough Street intersection in mid-June.

Queen Street

Near the Croquet Club

Track laying preparation and drainage work continues.

Barney Street

Track preparation works continue. The fishing platform has been reopened.

Nerang River

Work to construct the bridge piers continues. Girders will be delivered and installed throughout the week.

Nerang River Barge Movements

From early next week the larger barge will move to a more central position in the river with the navigation channel moving south of its charted position. Mariners are advised of the reduced overhead clearance at the temporary navigation span of 4 metres at the highest astronomical tide. Approaches to the bridge will be marked and vessels should use extreme caution when transiting this area and obey speed limits, buoys and signs. Paradise Waters

Construction along the Gold Coast Highway from the Gold Coast Bridge to Admiralty Drive continues.

Admiralty Park

Works to install underground services at Admiralty Park continue.

Admiralty Drive

Works to lay rail across Admiralty Drive will continue for up to four weeks. North and south bound traffic access into and out of Paradise Waters will be maintained, however points of access may change.

Surfers Paradise

Ferny Avenue to Main Beach Parade

Piling will continue between Ferny Avenue and Main Beach Parade.

Ocean Avenue to View Avenue

Underground service works continue. Temporary footpath closures may occur during this time. Works to lay rail also continue.

Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue

Work to lay rail continues. Underground service upgrades continue with works to be completed between 6.30pm and 6.30am, Sunday to Thursday. Surfers Paradise Boulevard is closed

to all through traffic between Elkhorn Avenue and Cavill Avenue.

Cavill Avenue to Clifford Street

Surfers Paradise Boulevard is now one-way southbound between Cavill Avenue and Clifford Street. From mid-May there will be no access from Beach Road onto Surfers Paradise Boulevard. Hanlan Street will be left turn only onto the boulevard. There will also be no access into Hanlan Street from Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

Cavill Avenue to Beach Road

Works to install underground services along the western footpath will begin. Temporary footpath closures will occur. Access will be maintained for all businesses.

Night works will occur on Wednesday 15 May and Thursday 16 May. These works require a temporary road closure of Surfers Paradise Boulevard from Cavill Avenue to Beach Road. Traffic management will be in place to assist motorists.

Trickett Street to Clifford Street

Night works to install underground services along the eastern footpath of Surfers Paradise Boulevard, between Laycock and Clifford Streets, will begin on Sunday 12 May and continue for three weeks. This work will take place between 6:30am and 6:30pm, from Sunday to Thursday.

Clifford to Thornton Street

Southbound traffic movements between [Clifford and Thornton Street](#) remain closed. East to west traffic movements are maintained at most intersections.

Clifford Street to Hamilton Avenue

Works to upgrade underground services and lay track in this area continue. From Monday 13 May works to install a new water main will begin on the western footpath. Temporary footpath closures may occur. Works to upgrade traffic signals at the Hamilton Avenue intersection will begin.

Hamilton Avenue to Markwell Avenue

Works to upgrade underground services and lay track in this area continue.

Markwell Avenue intersection to Enderley Avenue

Night works to reopen the intersection of Markwell Avenue will take place on Tuesday 14 May. Works to install services in the eastern and western footpaths continue. Temporary footpath closures will be in place.

Enderley Avenue Intersection to Vista Street

Work to install rail across the Enderley Avenue intersection continues. To maintain access at all times traffic will be reduced to a single lane and managed by temporary traffic signals. Underground service works continue south towards Vista Street and west of the intersection along Enderley Avenue. Temporary footpath closures will occur.

Vista Street to Thornton Street

Work to install rail across the Thornton Street intersection continue. To maintain access at all times traffic will be reduced to a single lane and managed by temporary traffic signals. Underground service upgrades across Vista Street and along the eastern footpath continue. Traffic management will be in place to assist vehicles and pedestrians.

Temporary lane closures will occur. Access to Queensland Avenue and Main Place will be maintained.

Main Place

Underground service works continue on the Gold Coast Highway adjacent to Main Place. Temporary lane closures on the highway will occur during the night.

Elizabeth Avenue intersection

Night works on 15 and 16 May will occur to complete traffic signal upgrades at the intersection. The intersection will be re-opened to traffic from 20 May 2013, weather permitting.

Hooker Boulevard and Jupiter's Casino Road

Lane closures at the intersection of Hooker Boulevard and Jupiter's Casino Road will occur between Monday 13 May and Wednesday 15 May. Jupiter's Casino northbound bus stop will be closed. For northbound 745 bus services please use Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre bus stop on the Gold Coast Highway. For northbound 750 bus services please use Victoria Park bus stop on Surf Parade (see map below).

Monaco Street Intersection

Rail works continue at the intersection of Monaco Street and the Gold Coast Highway. North and south bound detours are available via St Kilda Avenue and Wharf Road.

Wharf Road

Night works on 15 and 16 May at the intersection of Wharf Road and Cannes Avenue will occur. Periodic north bound lane closures of the Gold Coast Highway will be required.

Queensland Avenue

Underground service works continue on the eastern side of the Gold Coast Highway.
