Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast Line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldlinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors commenced construction in July 2016 and are committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.

Day Work

The following activities are planned to be undertaken during September, site condition and weather permitting:

Location	Day Work
Napper Road and Smith Street intersection	<p>Public utility services installation Intermittent work to install gas pipes, conduits and pits will be undertaken on the corner of Napper Road and Smith Street, including the park 'n' ride facility, from early September to November.</p> <p>Work will involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Excavation and trenching • Installation of power poles • Gas pipe installation and connection • Temporary lane closures and traffic changes from Thursday 22 September. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists. <p>NOTE: Night work is associated with this activity – see information in night work section overleaf.</p>
Olsen Avenue	<p>Public utility services location, relocation and protection Intermittent work to locate and relocate public utility services will be undertaken at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive from late September to December.</p> <p>Work will involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Potholing and identification of services • Service relocations and maintenance • Saw-cutting, excavation and road reconstruction • Concrete work including installation of formwork, pouring and concrete cutting • Pedestrian access will be maintained around the work area • Temporary lane closures and traffic changes. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists. <p>NOTE: Night work is associated with this activity – see information in night work section overleaf.</p>

Location	Day Work
Greenacre Drive and Henry Cotton Drive	<p>Public utility services location and relocation Location and relocation of public utility services at the entrances to Parkwood and Parkwood East Stations will be undertaken from September to December.</p> <p>Work will involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Saw-cutting/concrete work • Excavation of road surface • Road reconstruction and resurfacing • Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
Various locations within the light rail corridor	<p>Noise barrier construction and installation From early September noise barrier construction will begin behind Carner Court, several properties in Henry Cotton Drive, Stanton Court, Longcove Place and Longreef Crescent.</p> <p>Delivery of terrain leveller A terrain leveller will be delivered the week of Monday 12 September to begin excavating the rock within the light rail corridor behind Greenacre and Fairweather Drives. More information about the terrain leveller will be provided closer to the date to residents in proximity to the cuttings.</p> <p>Retaining wall construction In late September, piling rigs will arrive to commence construction of the three retaining walls located in the vicinity of the Smith Street Motorway (behind Faldo Court) and Smith Street (behind Fairweather Drive, Drysdale Lane and Jamieson Drive). The rigs may arrive at night under traffic control. More information about the delivery of the rigs will be provided closer to the date to residents in proximity to the retaining walls.</p>
Uplands Drive to Carner Court	<p>Temporary pedestrian footpath closure The 180 metre section of pedestrian footpath running alongside the Smith Street Motorway (from Uplands Drive to Carner Court) will be temporarily closed for up to six weeks commencing in late September to allow for the connection of public utility services. Signage will be installed at footpath entry points prior to the closure. More information about the footpath closure will be provided closer to the date to residents in proximity to the footpath.</p>
Faldo Court	<p>Permanent closure of Faldo Court From Monday 12 September, Faldo Court will permanently close to traffic to enable construction of the pedestrian entrance to Parkwood East Station.</p>



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Night Work

The following work needs to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest, site condition and weather permitting:

Location	Night Work
Smith Street Motorway	<p>Re-lining of sewer pipes Re-lining of sewer pipes will be undertaken at three locations along the Smith Street Motorway between 8:00pm and 6:00am from Monday 19 September and is expected to take up to three nights in each location to complete.</p> <p>Work will involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporary lane closure on the westbound left-hand lane along Smith Street Motorway. One lane will remain open to traffic • Temporary lighting in the work areas • Use of generator, air compressor and vacuum excavator • Trucks and machinery accessing the work area. • Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist and direct motorists.
Napper Road and Smith Street intersection	<p>Public utility services installation Intermittent night work to install gas pipes, conduits and pits will be undertaken on the corner of Napper Road and Smith Street, including the park 'n' ride facility, between 8.00pm and 5.00am from Thursday 15 September. This work will take approximately two weeks to complete. Additional night work is scheduled for October. Information about October night works will be provided closer to the date to residents in proximity to this intersection.</p> <p>Work will involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporary lane closures and traffic changes. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists • Excavation and trenching • Installation of conduits and pits • Temporary lighting in the work areas.
Olsen Avenue	<p>Identification of services Intermittent night work will be undertaken to relocate public utility services at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive between 7.00pm and 6.00am from Monday 12 September until late November.</p> <p>Work will involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporary lane closures and traffic changes. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists • Potholing and identification of services • Service relocations and maintenance • Saw-cutting, excavation and road reconstruction • Concrete work including installation of formwork, pouring and concrete cutting • Pedestrian access will be maintained around the work area.

Every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum for residents in proximity to the work, such as installing temporary noise blankets to shroud the work area.
