Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast Line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldlinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors, commenced construction in July 2016 and is committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.

Day Work

The following activities are planned to be undertaken during October, site condition and weather permitting:

Napper Road and Smith Street intersection	<p>Public utility services installation Intermittent work to install gas pipes, conduits and pits will continue on Napper Road, the corner of Napper Road and Smith Street, and the future park 'n' ride facility on Smith Street until November.</p> <p>Refer to the <i>Construction Update – September</i> for more detail, available at www.gclrstage2.com.au/stage2.</p> <p>Work includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporary lane closures and traffic changes. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists • The footpath along Smith Street from Kingston Drive to Napper Road will be temporarily closed for up to 8 weeks during the day only • The footpath from Smith Street, north along Napper Road will also be closed for up to 8 weeks during the day only • Night work is associated with this work – see information in night work section overleaf. <p>Widening of access into future park 'n' ride Work will commence from Tuesday 4 October to re-align and widen the access into the future park 'n' ride opposite Napper Road.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporary single lane closure westbound on Smith Street. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists.
Smith Street Motorway	<p>Re-lining of sewer pipes Re-lining of sewer pipes will continue along the Smith Street Motorway between 7.00am and 2.00pm until early November.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporary lane closures and traffic changes. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists. <p>Refer to the <i>Construction Update – September</i> for more detail.</p>

Olsen Avenue	<p>Public utility services location, relocation and protection Intermittent work to locate and relocate public utility services will continue at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive until December.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporary lane closures and traffic changes. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists • Night work is associated with this activity – see information in night work section overleaf. <p>Refer to the <i>Construction Update – September</i> for more detail.</p>
Greenacre Drive and Henry Cotton Drive	<p>Public utility services location and relocation Location and relocation of public utility services at the entrances to Parkwood and Parkwood East Stations will continue until December.</p> <p>Refer to the <i>Construction Update – September</i> for more detail.</p>
Various locations within the light rail corridor	<p>Noise barrier construction and installation Noise barrier construction will continue behind Carner Court, several properties in Henry Cotton Drive, Stanton Court, Longcove Place and Longreef Crescent.</p> <p>Retaining wall construction From Wednesday 5 October, piling will begin for the three retaining walls located in the vicinity of the Smith Street Motorway (behind Faldo Court) and Smith Street (behind Fairweather Drive, Drysdale Lane and Jamieson Drive).</p>
Uplands Drive to Carner Court	<p>Temporary pedestrian footpath closure The 180 metre section of pedestrian footpath running alongside the Smith Street Motorway (from Uplands Drive to Carner Court) will be closed from mid-October for up to six weeks to allow for the connection of public utility services.</p> <p>More information about the footpath closure will be provided closer to the date.</p>
Bailey Crescent, Southport	<p>Light Rail Depot – Stabling yard construction Preliminary work to expand the light rail stabling facility in Southport has commenced and will continue until early 2017.</p> <p>More information about the stabling yard is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au/stage2 a</p>
Biggera Creek	<p>Piling – Biggera Creek Bridge Piling for the Biggera Creek Bridge will commence on Thursday 27 October. More information about the construction of the Biggera Creek Bridge will be provided closer to the date to residents in proximity of the bridge.</p>
Gold Coast University Hospital Station	<p>Gold Coast University Hospital Station Work to construct the connection from the existing station at the Gold Coast University Hospital to Stage 2 of the Light Rail will commence in late October.</p> <p>More information about the work will be provided closer to the date to residents and businesses in proximity to the Gold Coast University Hospital.</p>



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Night Work

The following work needs to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest, site condition and weather permitting:

Location	Night Work
Smith Street Motorway	<p>Re-lining of sewer pipes Re-lining of sewer pipes will continue along the Smith Street Motorway between 7.00pm and 7.00am until early November.</p> <p>Work includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporary lane closures on the westbound left-hand lane along Smith Street Motorway. Two lanes will remain open to traffic • Temporary lighting in the work areas • Use of generator, air compressor and vacuum extractor • Trucks and machinery accessing the work area • Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist and direct motorists. <p>Delivery of piling rig On Wednesday 5 October and Monday 10 October, early morning deliveries of piling machines will occur from 2.00am, weather permitting into the project corridor from the Smith Street Motorway. Due to the length of the truck and trailer and limited space within the project corridor, temporary lane closures are required.</p>
Napper Road and Smith Street intersection	<p>Public utility services installation Intermittent night work to install gas pipes, conduits and pits will be undertaken on the corner of Napper Road and Smith Street, including the future park 'n' ride facility, between 10.00pm and 5.00am from Tuesday 4 October. This work will take approximately three weeks to complete. Additional night work is scheduled for November. Information about November night works will be provided closer to the date to residents in proximity to this intersection.</p> <p>Work includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporary lane closures and traffic changes. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists • Excavation and trenching • Installation of conduits and pits • Temporary lighting in the work areas.
Olsen Avenue	<p>Identification of services Intermittent night work to relocate public utility services at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive will continue between 7.00pm and 5.00am until late November.</p> <p>Work includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporary lane closures and traffic changes. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists • Potholing and identification of services • Service relocations and maintenance • Saw-cutting, excavation and road reconstruction • Concrete work including installation of formwork, pouring and concrete cutting • Pedestrian access will be maintained around the work area.



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Every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum for residents in proximity to the work, such as installing temporary noise blankets to shroud the work area.
