Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

COOMBABAH CREEK BRIDGE BEAM DELIVERY



Over three nights on 3,6,8 February 2017, fifteen (15) bridge beams will be delivered to Coombabah Creek Bridge, from 12.00am to 5.00am, weather and construction conditions permitting.

The Coombabah Creek Bridge contains three (3) spans or sections for a total bridge length of 33 metres. Each span is comprised of five (5) beams and each beam weighs 60 tonnes. The delivery of the beams will occur with five trucks, each transporting a single beam at a time over the three nights.

The beam deliveries will enter into the project alignment eastbound via Smith Street, Parkwood (3 and 6 February) and southbound via Country Club Drive, Helensvale (8 February). Traffic control will assist motor vehicles as the trucks turning abilities are restricted. Due to the length of the bridge beams, trucks are only permitted to travel during off peak times.

Every effort will be made to minimise truck noise during the delivery of these bridge beams. We appreciate your patience during this important work and will continue to update you as work progresses.

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast Line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldlinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors commenced construction in July 2016 and are committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.
