




PROJECT MANAGERS & DESIGN

Guidelines to keep in mind to setup your designers for success:

- Designers need to understand constraints
- Designers need existing branding and assets early
- Goals and requirements must be clear
- Involve the designer on the **discovery call** when applicable
- Understand why the client is redesigning when possible and when applicable
- Assigning the correct designer for the job





DESIGNING FOR DEVELOPMENT

Guidelines to keep in mind to setup your PM and developers for success:

- Design on a 12 column grid system (Bootstrap)
- Responsive Design is standard and designs should keep this in mind and represent mobile, tablet, and desktop
- Know your constraints
 - Budget
 - o Time
 - Feature
- Understand existing assets, branding, style guides
- **Clarify** requests
- **Supply assets** deliverables with final designs





DEVELOPERS & DESIGN

Guidelines to keep in mind to develop designs successfully and reduce back and forth with PM and design team:

- Think about and be aware of:
 - Alignment
 - Spacing
 - Line height
 - o Font size, weight, and styles
 - Color pallette
- All designs should be on a grid system
- All designs should be delivered with optimized assets in linked client folder
- Responsive design is standard and must be developed and tested






PM DELIVERABLES FOR DESIGNERS

WHAT IS A GRID SYSTEM?

Designers will be designing on a 12 column grid with gutters according to project specs.

Default Template Specs:


• Width w/ gutters: 1200px

• **Designable Width:** 1170px

• **Gutter width:** 15px (gutters can be removed)

Larger designs and widths can be chosen dependent on the requirement and spec but this will be the default starting place for design files moving forward.

Developers will receive final max-widths with design delivery for each project.









DESIGN SPEC: FLOW INDICATORS



DESIGN SPEC: STYLE GUIDE








DESIGN SPEC: MEASURING TOOLS

OPTIMIZED IMAGES AND ELEMENTS

Guidelines for images and elements:

- Designer to provide optimized images
- Developers need verify optimized images
- Preferred format for elements is SVG
- If SVG is not possible then optimized and sized elements will be provided (2x, 3x, etc.)
- All assets will be delivered via client asset folder.
