Scholarship Award Information & Rules

The Arabian Horse Association of Arizona Education Trust is dedicated to furthering the rich legacy of the Arabian horse and equestrian sport through higher education, personal development, and enhanced emotional wellbeing through friendly Equine competition. Scholarship winners are entitled to payment of funds for higher educational purposes. Higher education is defined as an institution/school of higher learning, which a scholarship winner attends upon receiving a high school diploma or equivalent. This definition shall include colleges, universities, junior or community colleges offering an Associate Degree, or trade schools that issue certificates for a specific trade. The scholarship monies will be paid directly to the institution/school on behalf of the scholarship winner. The scholarship funds will be dispursed for tuition, books, or expenses directly related to education only (using scholarship funds for meals and lodging will be excluded). The amount to be paid to an institution on behalf of the scholarship winner is the face value of the award when won; no award shall be increased/decreased by interest earnings/losses which back the *award*. If for any reason the tuition and books are less than the amount dispursed or the student does not attend school to fulfill the dispursed scholarship, they must be refunded to the Arabian Horse Association of Arizona (not the student). *The trust will hold the money for 10 years from the year it was won; after that time, it will expire and will no longer be available for redemption.*

The winner of the scholarship must provide the Education Trust with the following information in writing for distribution:

3. Birthdate of the scholarship winner _____
4. Year and class name the scholarship was won _____
5. Name of institution/school, include department name and address that the check needs to be sent to

6. The name and telephone number of an individual to contact at the institution _____

7. School issued student ID number _____
8. The amount of the payment required _____
9. The date payment is required _____
10. Include confirmation of enrollment at the institution named above (*copy of the acceptance letter or a letter from school confirming registration or confirmed class schedule*)

Funds will be issued promptly but cannot be guaranteed unless sufficient time is given to confirm enrollment and release funds. By submitting this application the student and parents agree to abide by the Education Trust General Rules.
