

Heavy Vehicle safety requirements

All frequent heavy vehicles arriving on this site must comply with Sydney Metro's heavy vehicle safety requirements



Driver Safety

Drivers must have a valid driving licence for the vehicle they are driving.

Drivers must have completed the Sydney Metro Industry Curriculum Safe Heavy Vehicle Driver Introduction Course.

Vehicle Safety

Frequent Heavy Vehicles (i.e. over 4.5t GVM) must be compliant with the following safety technology and equipment fitted:

1. Blind-spot minimisation:
 - Class V and VI mirrors; or
 - An alternative method of eliminating vehicle blind-spots (e.g. camera system and/or sensor system). Note: the system must be working
2. Side Underrun Protection (both sides) between front and rear axle
3. Telematics Monitoring System to monitor vehicle location and speed
4. Vulnerable road user warning signage (fitted to rear and passenger side)
5. Enhanced conspicuity markings (e.g. Yellow to the sides, red to the rear)
