DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Colorado has declared a statewide emergency regarding the occurrence or imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the District to have emergency resources available to work to safeguard the health and safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, pursuant C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709 the District's General Manager is authorized to declare a local disaster emergency; and

WHEREAS, the effect of the declaration of a local disaster emergency is to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local and interjurisdictional disaster emergency plans and to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance under such plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Section 1. The District's General Manager hereby declares, pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709, a local disaster emergency for Cordillera, due to the imminent threat caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. The General Manager is implementing measures with respect to District employees and access to certain District owned facilities.

Section 2. This Declaration shall be effective until March 20, 2020, unless continued by the District's Board of Directors. This declaration shall be filed with the Eagle County Clerk and Recorder's Office and with the Colorado Office of Emergency Management.



The General Manager is directed to continue implementing measures with respect to District employees and access to certain District owned facilities.
