Have you applied for your Regional Seniors Travel Card?

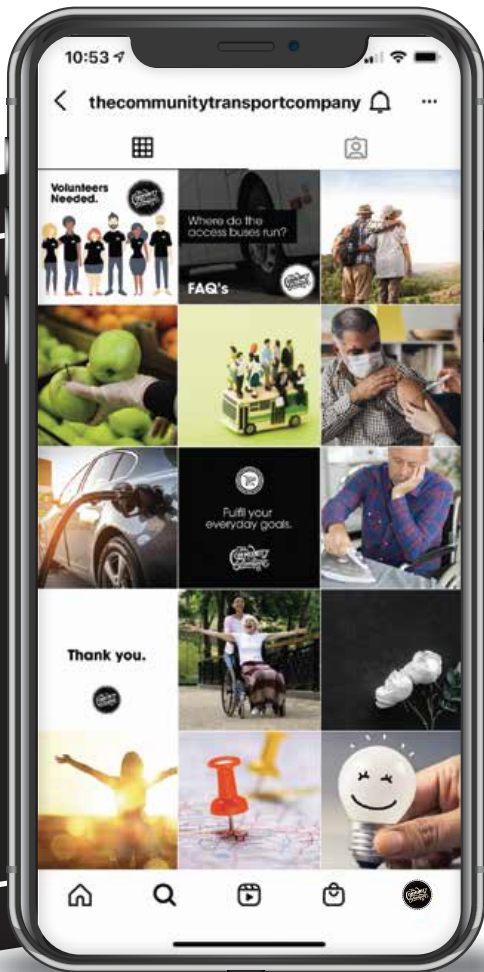
