White hydrangeas bloom displaying their lavish, rounded shape, as do several varieties of David Austin English roses, ranunculus, dahlias, tulips, cosmos and asters. Find an assortment of seasonal florals to welcome the changing of the seasons. Watch the ornamental grasses, Bells of Ireland and eucalyptus dance in the wind. Blueberries, raspberries, aronia berries, apple and pear trees provide flavorful fruit, along with many other varieties thriving on the farm.



CELEBRATIONS FAQS

Q. WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN WEDDINGS, PRIVATE + SEMI-PRIVATE CELEBRATIONS?

Our weddings of approximately 100 guests have exclusive access to the farm for up to 10 hours to celebrate. Private celebrations give you exclusive access to the farm for an hourly rate (for a minimum of three hours) + are boutique-sized with a guest count of about 100. Semi-private celebrations are geared toward a smaller guest count, rented by the hour, and may share the farm with other guests.

Q. DO I HAVE TO USE A ROSE FARM CATERER + BEVERAGE SERVICE?

We encourage you to use any caterer or food truck of your choice. All beverage options, both alcoholic and non-alcoholic, must be purchased through the farm.

Q. IS THERE A VENUE FEE?

Our weddings start at \$4,000, our private celebrations start at \$450/hour, and our semiprivate celebrations start at \$250/hour.

Q. DO YOU ALLOW DECORATIONS?

We love decorations! We kindly ask that you do not use confetti, glitter or fireworks of any kind.

Q. WHAT TYPE OF MUSIC IS ALLOWED AT THE FARM?

We know that music is a big part of your experience. The farm has a Sonos speaker system for you to enjoy. We honor our neighborhood noise ordinance which does not include DJ's or loud music. Our farm kindly asks that all music is turned off by 9 PM.

Q. WHEN RENTING THE FARM, WHAT TIME DO I NEED TO CONCLUDE MY CELEBRATION? All celebrations must conclude by no later than 10 PM.

Q. DO YOU HAVE A DAY-OF COORDINATOR TO HELP WITH THE CELEBRATION?

We have a wonderful Celebration Coordinator who is on-site to make sure your experience at our farm is exceptional.

Q. DO I HAVE THE OPTION TO HAVE ROSE FARM CLEAN UP AFTER MY CELEBRATION?

The farm happily cleans-up following a wedding celebration for no additional fee. We are happy to do the clean up after your private or semi-private celebration for a fee of \$150. If you choose not to use our cleaning service, you are responsible for all clean-up at the conclusion of your celebration.

Q. CAN I BRING MY DECORATIONS AHEAD OF MY CELEBRATION?

Absolutely! We will store your decorations + any additional supplies for you.

Q. DO YOU OFFER CELEBRATION PLANNING SERVICES?

We offer planning services for \$100/hour. We can help you with menu selection, table card creation, party design, vendors, decorating, and another other requested details.

Q. WHERE ARE PRIVATE CELEBRATIONS TYPICALLY HELD?

The farm has 25 acres of possibilities. Seasonally, our Rose Farm Garden Pavilion + outdoor gardens are a beautiful setting for celebrations.

SEMI-PRIVATE CELEBRATIONS FAQS

Q. WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PRIVATE + SEMI-PRIVATE?

Our private celebrations of approximately 100 guests have exclusive access to the farm, with a three hour booking minimum. Semi-private celebrations are geared toward a smaller guest count, rented by the hour, and they may share the farm with other guests.

Q. DO I NEED TO SET UP + TEAR DOWN MY EVENT?

The farm will set your celebration with tables + chairs. Our team is also happy to do your event styling + set-up for an additional fee. You have two options for tear down; you can add an additional hour onto your celebration and do it yourself, or you can schedule our team for an extra fee of \$150 to handle all the clean-up.

Q. DO YOU HAVE ITEMS THAT I MAY USE FOR MY CELEBRATION?

We would love for you to use our floral China, silverware + glassware for 50 guests or less.

Q. DO I HAVE TO USE THE FARM FOR CATERING + BEVERAGE SERVICES?

We encourage you to use any caterer or food truck of your choice. All beverage options, both alcoholic and non-alcoholic, must be purchased through the farm.

Q. DO YOU HAVE AN ON-SITE COORDINATOR FOR SEMI-PRIVATE?

Our Celebration Coordinator is on-site to ensure that your time at the farm is exceptional.

Q. What if I want to bring food, decorations, etc before my celebration?

We are happy to store your items before your celebration. We have extra refrigerators, if needed.

Q. What if I want to style my own flowers or my budget is very small?

We offer DIY buckets so you can have beautiful florals for your celebration centered around your budget. These buckets are full of processed flowers ready to be styled *(not for resale)*. We kindly ask that you do not bring florals on-site from another vendor or grower.

Q. MAY MY GROUP TOUR THE FARM BEFORE OR AFTER OUR CELEBRATION?

We would love to schedule a guided tour of the farm.

Q. CAN MY SEMI-PRIVATE CELEBRATION BE INDOORS OR OUTDOORS?

We would love to host your group inside in The Shoppe OR outdoors in The Garden Pavilion.

PHOTOGRAPHY FAQS

Q. WHEN DOES THE FARM OPEN THE CALENDAR FOR PHOTOGRAPHY?

The farm opens for photographers for the spring season on May 17, 2024. You can find our full calendar on our website under the photography tab. Photographers may begin booking on March 1, 2024.

Q. When I book my session, what does that include?

The farm has 25 acres to create the perfect backdrop for your session. In the fall + winter seasons, the greenhouse is professionally styled.

Q. DO YOU HAVE A RESTROOM FOR MY CLIENT TO CHANGE?

The farm has a restroom located inside The Shoppe that may be accessed during open farm hours only.

Q. WHAT IF I AM NOT A PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHER?

We kindly ask you to reserve an appointment on our website. Your reserved time gives you exclusive access to the greenhouse. You'll find a 15 minute session if you're looking to snap just a few photos — whether it's on a professional camera or iPhone — or you'll find a one-hour session.

Q. CAN I BRING A PROP FOR MY SESSION?

You are welcome to bring any props. We ask that you take everything with you when you leave. Photographers will incur a cleaning fee if Rose Farm is required to clean after the session.

GARDEN CLUB FAQS

Q. DO I HAVE TO PICK UP MY BUCKET THE WEEK OF JUNE 8TH?

You are welcome to pick up your bucket any time after June 5, 2024.

Q. WHAT CAN I EXPECT WHEN I JOIN THE GARDEN CLUB?

The Garden Club was designed for those who want to enjoy flowers on a regular basis. You will receive a bucket + shears that you will use as often as you like to refill your bucket. You will receive a farm tour + easy techniques to harvest your flowers. Each refill is \$10 less than the pick-your-own bucket offering.

Q. What if I don't have time to Mingle through the Gardens to harvest my flowers?

As part of the Garden Club, we are happy to fill your bucket from our daily harvest from the fields with pre-cut florals. You'll be able to grab & go!

Q. What types of flowers can I expect to harvest?

Our four gardens are full of seasonal blooms, and each season brings new offerings to the Garden Club. Flowers are not for resale.

THE FARM FAQS

Q. DO YOU CHARGE A FEE TO TOUR THE FARM?

We do not charge a fee to visit our farm.

Q. What day/time is the farm open?

The farm has seasonal hours from April-December.

Q. CAN I BRING FOOD + BEVERAGE TO THE FARM?

We invite you to bring a picnic, snack or any other type of food. The farm provides beverages, and has a curated beverage menu of both alcoholic and non-alcoholic options available for purchase. Per Iowa law, all on-site alcohol must be purchased by Rose Farm.

Q. WHAT CAN I EXPECT WHEN I VISIT THE FARM?

We encourage you to take a sabbatical when you arrive at the farm. Grab a glass of sweet tea or wine + mingle through the gardens and pick a bucket of florals. Stop in The Shoppe for curated local gifts or sit in one of our Adirondack chairs and watch the birds in our bird habitats.

Q. WHAT IF I WANT TO GRAB A QUICK PHOTO IN THE SWEET LITTLE GREENHOUSE?

If you're hoping to grab a quick photo, whether it's on your iPhone or your camera, we ask you to book a session on our website. We offer 15-minute sessions.

Q. CAN I BRING MY DOG TO THE FARM?

We love animals of all kinds. We kindly ask that they are on a leash.

Q. CAN I PICK FLOWERS DURING OPEN FARM HOURS?

You can mingle through the gardens to pick a bucket of flowers, or you can pick up a pre-made market bouquet in The Shoppe.

Q. WHAT IF I WANT TO BRING A GROUP OF FRIENDS TO THE FARM?

We will be over here jumping for joy! If you want to enjoy the farm during open hours you are welcome to contact us ahead of time + we will reserve Adirondack chairs, or we can set a table for you.

Q. DO YOU OFFER PRIVATE TOURS?

We are happy to tour your group. You are welcome to contact the farm to schedule a time that works for you.

FARM SCHOOL FAQS

Q. WHAT IS FARM SCHOOL?

Farm School offers young children a front row seat to a modern farmstead. Join us each Friday, June-August, for a complimentary 45-minute Farm School session. With exciting lessons on pollinators, chickens, flowers and more, children will listen to a story + enjoy hands-on learning activities.

Q. DO I NEED TO RESERVE A TIME FOR MY KIDDO?

No reservation is necessary. Farm School starts on the hour at 9, 10 + 11 AM June-August. Updates + schedules can be found on Facebook + Instagram.

Q. IS THERE A LIMIT ON HOW MANY KIDDOS I CAN BRING?

There is no limit to the amount of children you bring along. We ask that there is an appropriate ratio of adult to children supervision being provided.

Q. WHAT AGE SHOULD MY KIDDO BE IF ATTENDING?

We welcome all ages as there are sensory experiences beneficial to even the youngest guest.

Our lessons + stories are geared toward elementary children.

Q. WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT WHEN ATTENDING FARM SCHOOL?

Plan to join us for a lesson on pollinators, chickens, flowers and more. This complimentary event includes a story, a short, educational lesson, a hands-on learning activity + a craft.

Each session begins on the hour at 9, 10 + 11 AM.

The Shoppe offers a selection of beverages for purchase. We also include pop-up food vendors, on occasion. Follow along on our social media channels for the full schedule.

Q. CAN I BRING FOOD + BEVERAGE?

You are welcome to bring food to your workshoppe. We have a wonderful selection of both alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverage options for you to purchase and enjoy.

Q. WHAT IF I WANT TO BE SEATED WITH FRIENDS?

We love for you to experience our farm with your friends/family. When you register for your workhoppe, we have a drop-down box where you can make a note of with whom you'd like to be seated.

Our team of Educators provide all necessary materials for each workshoppe.

PRIVATE WORKSHOPPES + DINNERS

Q. DO I NEED TO RENT THE FARM ALONG WITH MY WORKSHOPPE/DINNER TICKET? Your workshoppe/dinner ticket is all you will need for your private event.

Q. WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A PRIVATE CULINARY WORKSHOPPE + PRIVATE FARM TO TABLE DINNER?

Our culinary workshoppe is an interactive, hands-on education experience. The farm to table dinner is a 5 course, pre-fixed dinner for small groups who will sit back and enjoy the courses as they are served.

Q. CAN I SCHEDULE A FARM TOUR BEFORE OR AFTER MY PRIVATE CELEBRATION AT THE FARM?

Our team would love to tour your group while you are at the farm. Let us know if you prefer before or after your celebration.

Q. WILL MY PRIVATE WORKSHOPPE BE INDOORS OR OUTDOORS?

Typically, it depends on the workshoppe. Please let us know if you have a preference.

Q. HOW MANY GUESTS ARE THE PRIVATE WORKSHOPPES + DINNERS DESIGNED TO HOLD?

Our private workshoppes are designed for 8-40 guests, and the private farm to table dinners are designed for 20+ guests.


