

Faith to be Healed!

Acts 14:8 And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:

9 The same heard Paul speak who steadfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed,

10 Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.

This man crippled from birth heard the apostle Paul (**preach/teach**)!

All he did was **believe** what he heard about Jesus Christ being Savior, Lord and Healer.

While Paul was teaching, he was looking out over the crowd and noticed this crippled man and **perceived** (knew in his heart) he had the faith to be **healed**!

Healed means “*restored, made well and whole*” with his legs functioning the way God intended.

So, Paul said with a loud voice (**command**) “**Stand up right**”!

Then the man **jumped up and walked**!

This man born crippled was **healed** because he **heard The Word of God, believed** it and **acted** upon it!

Galatians 3:2 This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or *by the hearing of faith?*

Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

There can be **no faith** where the will of God is **not** known, but when the will of God is **known and believed** **faith** is born.

- **And faith gives birth to miracles!**

Galatians 3:5 He therefore that ministered to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

Paul said God supplied the people with the gift of The Holy Spirit by them **believing and receiving** The Word of God!

God also supplied **miracles, signs and wonders** by the people believing and receiving The Word of God!

Acts 14:3 Paul and Barnabas stayed in the city of Iconium for a long time. They spoke boldly about the Lord, who confirmed their message about his good will by having them perform miracles and do amazing things.

God worked with Paul and Barnabas when they spoke boldly about Jesus who confirmed (backed up) their message (claims) about God's good will to save heal and set people free from the devil's oppression.

Acts 19:11 And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul: 12 So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

God was using Paul so much in **signs, wonders, and miracles** the people **believed** anything that touched Paul was **anointed** with the power of The Holy Ghost!

Matthew 9:27 And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, Thou Son of David, have mercy on us.

*28 And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, **Believe ye that I am able to do this?** They said unto him, Yea, Lord.*

*29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, **According to your faith be it unto you.***

*30 And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, **See that no man know it.***

Jesus asked the blind man did he **believe** He was **able** to heal him!

- **Do you have faith to be Healed today?**

Do you believe Jesus still heals today?

Luke 6:19 And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him and healed them all.

Use your **faith** today, reach out and touch Jesus for virtue, anointing, and power is present to heal you today!

Jesus healed all who came to Him!

Acts 5:15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.

Acts 5:16 There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

God also anoints His servants with **The Holy Ghost and power** to saves souls, heal the sick and raise the dead.

Peter was so anointed that people were brought out into the streets so Peter could just **walk by** and his **shadow**.

The **image** of Peter was as powerful as the **person of Peter!**

Well Peter, Paul and all Jesus disciples (including all saints) are the image of the risen Christ and given the same power He used while on earth.

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do, because I go unto my Father.

All who **place their faith in Jesus Christ** have the faith to be saved, healed, and delivered.

We also have the faith to bring the **same power** to the lives of all who are **oppressed of the devil**, doing greater works in His Name!
