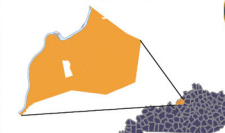

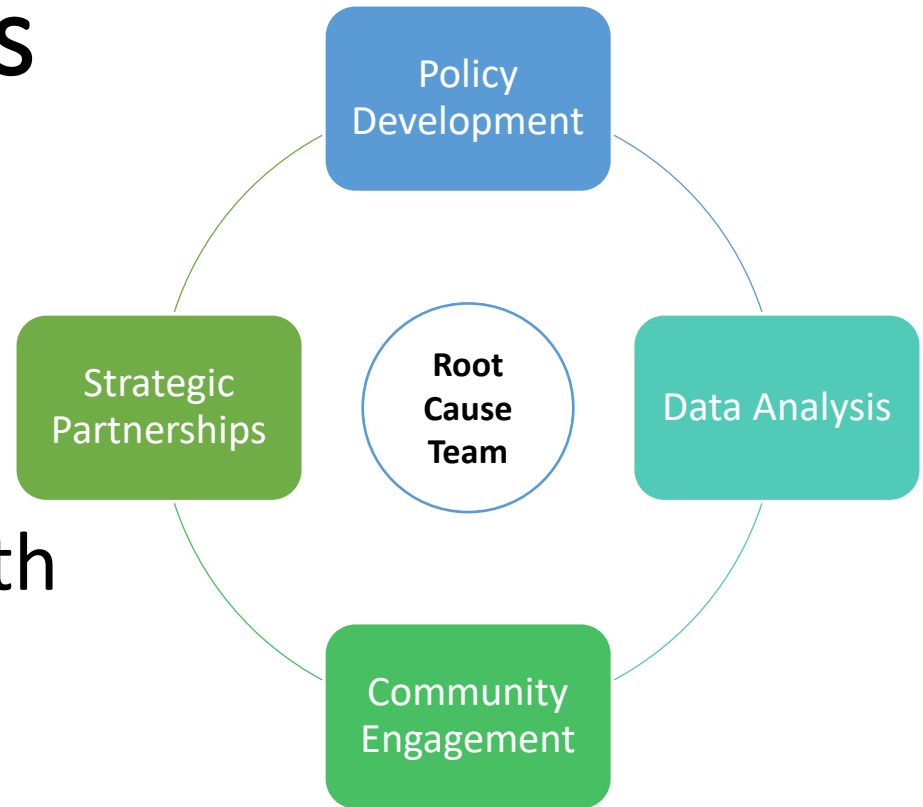
Root Cause Teams Work Plan
