#### **REFLECTION**

Are you a hand-sitter? It's a serious question. Too many of us are just that - hand-sitters. I'll let someone else take the lead. I'll make a donation, but don't ask me to get involved. It's just not my way!

To those of us who are hand-sitters, Mary addresses us directly in today's feast. 'Mary set out and went as quickly as she could.... She was never going to be accused of hand-sitting. We might have understood her if, hearing the news of her albeit miraculous conception, in this weekend's Gospel, she chose to take things easy, focussing on herself and the child growing inside her. No! She set out and went as quickly as she could.... She couldn't sit and do nothing. Her elderly cousin was in need of her help. There will have been other cousins, neighbours, friends any number of people on hand to help. That wasn't good enough for Mary, and no matter how arduous the journey she would undertake it. SHE WOULD NOT DO NOTHING!

At the present time we seem to be living at the mercy of hand-sitters. For many of us stress levels are high and we seem to be no more than voyeurs looking in on a party political process that is at best incestuous and at worst a battle to see who can promote the most extreme of views. Apparently the British Government can do nothing until early September. This is taking hand sitting to dizzying heights.

I have reached saturation point. I don't want Mary, the Mother of God, to give me a hard time when we eventually meet. I don't want her to ask the question: Was there nothing you could do? This is not the medium to speak of what I have decided to do. I have acted and will continue to do so. Initial awkwardness and feeling like a bit of a fish out of water, quickly dissipated as I realised, I was not alone. Others had got off their hands, they were happy to be recipients of my support and reciprocated with their own love and support in return. We may not have all of the answers, but we will search and not rest till we find them. Don't be a hand-sitter — take your lead from Mary, the Mother of God.
