### TASTING NOTE

A restrained savory wine with vivid aromas and earthy tones with cranberry and cherries fruits. There are fresh cut violets, iris, and Pomegranate with a hint of cherry, plum, and raspberry. Subtle notes of potting soil form a backdrop to its sweet and flowery flavors. The wine has a moderate acidity combined with the tartness of red fruits and structural tannins.

Gamay and Savoie? Can do. Very light and transparent, gossamer texture, crisp acidity, barely there cherry flavours, cranberry tang and powdery tannins that pucker to finish. Some succulence here, the wine builds as it opens, but it will never be more than feathery and flighty, and lovely in that way. Pleasing, pleasant, delicate drink.

**DOMAINE DE CHATILLON MONDEUSE 2018**

Mondeuse is one of those red grape varieties that seem to have inbuilt ‘minerality’, for want of a better word, like Teroldego does. This is from 40-50 year old vines. This is, I think, what you might call a ‘Mike Bennie Wine’. Redcurrant, fresh blueberry and raspberry, a dusting of white pepper and crushed rock, meat and violet. It’s light in body, crunchy and fresh, cool cranberry acidity, dry and ‘minerally’. It’s kind of bony, but still packs in plenty of flavour, finish has pumice stone tannin and a sour cherry edge. If you want big and bold, look elsewhere, but the charm and drinking appeal here is so high, so refreshing, that it’s hard not to gulp. Value.

Love a good jacquere , Flinty scents , green herbs ,wet ferns , green pear. Nice sniffs . Tight & racy to taste , feels lie a wine for fondue , cut that cheese & grease. Light & lean , simple wine , done well , refreshing , but yeah , simple as. Decent drink.

Medium to light ruby colour with a tinge of purple . The bouquet is shy but appealing , foresty & savoury , with dried flowers , pot pourri hints & a cherry bon bon background. The wine is soft & light bodied , easy going with gentle texture & very light tannins. It retains its savouriness without tannin impact. A very moreish light bodied , current drinking red.

**90 POINTS HUON HOOKE – THE REAL REVIEW**

**DOMAINE DE CHATILLON MONDEUSE 2017**

Medium red / purple colour , youthful & bright. The wine is savoury & drying with good fruit flavour & a light but positive tannin grip. The acidity is bright but balanced , the wine has appetising qualities & good intensity & impact, with medium body. It has dark cherry fruit as well as earthy & leathery savoury characteristics.



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
