DECONTAMINATION, DEMOLITION AND DECOMMISSIONING:



IKON provides decontamination of building surfaces, contents and other items containing surface contamination of hazardous materials. We remove heavy metals, pesticides, PCB's and other contaminants from the affected surfaces so that the contaminated structures can be reused or disposed of at a non-hazardous facility.

GROUNDWATER SYSTEM INSTALLATION:



IKON has installed groundwater treatment and extraction systems for public entities, major oil and petrochemical companies, private landowners, engineering companies and consulting firms. These systems remove a variety of organic and inorganic contaminants and typically employ one or more of the following treatment strategies:

- Carbon adsorption
- Air stripping
- Steam stripping
- Chemical oxidation
- Biological oxidation
- Phase separation
- Neutralization
- Precipitation



LANDFILL CONSTRUCTION AND CAPPING:

IKON's full range of services includes the construction of new storage facilities ranging from temporary containment areas for contaminated soils to sophisticated operational landfill units for disposal of industrial waste. Capping systems are constructed to achieve secure isolation of waste materials from the environment. Our services in this area include: RCRA Impoundment Construction Landfill Construction and Closure:

SOIL REMEDIATION:



IKON personnel have successfully applied a wide range of treatment methods to soil contaminated with solvents, pesticides, heavy metals, petroleum compounds and other pollutants. HEALTH AND SAFETY PROGRAM

The Health and Safety Program at IKON is a comprehensive behavioral based program developed to minimize unsafe conditions and promote safe work practices throughout the organization. IKON's employees are provided with the necessary training and equipment to perform their tasks in a safe and efficient manner. IKON understands that all accidents and occupational injuries are preventable. IKON's Health and Safety Program consists of, but is not limited to, the following elements:

- Electrical Safety (Lock Out / Tag Out)
- Controls to Minimize Exposures

- Confined Space Entry and Rescue
- Ladders and Scaffolds
- Employee Training and Medical Monitoring
- Site Inspections
- Housekeeping

Each project manager is responsible for identifying the chemical and physical hazards that may exist on project sites and implementing controls that are necessary to protect personnel on site. Large-scale remediation projects are assigned a site safety officer to implement and check site safety procedures. All IKON managers have a fiscal, as well as a moral obligation to provide a safe workplace for their employees and to investigate each accident in order to identify corrective actions to minimize the reoccurrence of that accident. Our safety professionals are involved in all safety-related matters, including medical monitoring and safety training programs and procedures.

Employee health and safety is top priority on all IKON managed work sites. The success of our Health and Safety Program rests in the firm commitment of all members of our workforce to plan and practice safety every day. Through everyone's efforts, IKON constantly improves safety techniques and reduces hazards. Each employee is required to take part in making the workplace safe by using the safety equipment provided, by avoiding unsafe practices and acts, by cooperating with their supervisor and by following established safety guidelines.
