Now Representing Peter Schlesinger

New York, November 17, 2021 – David Lewis is pleased to announce the representation of American artist **Peter Schlesinger** whose exhibition of new sculpture will open at the gallery in January 2022.

Schlesinger was born and raised in Los Angeles in 1948. After studying painting at the University of California, Los Angeles, he went to London's Slade School of Art in the late 1960s and early 1970s and began making sculpture in New York in the mid 1980s.

Schlesinger's ceramic works include figurative sculptures that evoke mythology and fables as well as vessels that reference ancient forms and enigmatic biomorphic shapes with inventive glazes and textures.
