

Q52 LESSON 25 Can Jesus Help Me See Clearly?

Biblical Concept: Clarity

Scripture Passage to Read: John 9:1–41

KEY POINTS

- Spiritual arrogance will make you blind. You may sound smart but will miss Jesus.
- The healing of the blind man is a reflection of our own spiritual journeys from darkness to light.
- We don't need to prove everything we believe about Jesus so long as we are clear about this one thing: once I was blind, but now I see.

THIS WEEK

Day 1 (Eyes): After reading chapter 25 in Quest 52, consider this question: Are you in danger of spiritual arrogance?

Day 2 (Ears): Read 2 Samuel 22. How did David use the metaphor of darkness and light to refer to God's saving work? Bonus question: Where else do we find this poem?

Day 3 (Heart): Meditate on 2 Corinthians 4:6; Ephesians 1:18; Revelation 3:17.

Day 4 (Voice): Discussion:

- How is darkness portrayed in movies and other popular media? What does it represent?
- What was the darkest day of your life? The brightest day of your life?
- Do people in the dark know they are in the dark? Why do people in the dark think people in the light are blind? Extra credit: Read the allegory of the cave in Plato's Republic.
- Do you know of areas of your life where you don't think or see clearly? How does spiritual arrogance cause blindness?

Day 5 (Hands): Ask someone who knows you well and whom you trust as wise (whether Christian or not) what your blind spots might be.
