This Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how we use cookies, how third parties we may partner with may use cookies on the Service, your choices regarding cookies and further information about cookies.

What are cookies & how are they used

Cookies are small pieces of information, normally consisting of just letters and numbers, which online services provide when users visit them. Software on the user's device (for example a web browser) can store cookies and send them back to the website next time you visit.

Cookies are a specific technology that store information between website visits. They are used in numerous ways, such as:

- Help make a website useable by enabling page navigation and accessing secure areas of a website
- remembering what's in a shopping basket when shopping for goods online.
- supporting users to log in to a website.
- analysing traffic to a website; or
- tracking users' browsing behaviour.

Cookies can be useful because they allow a website to recognise a user's device. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. Without cookies, or some other similar method, websites would have no way to 'remember' anything about visitors, such as how many items are in a shopping basket or whether they are logged in.

When you use and access the Service, we may place a number of cookies files in your web browser.

We use cookies for the following purposes:

- To help make the website useable by enabling page navigation
- We analyse traffic coming to and from our website
- Track users browsing behaviour

We use both session and persistent cookies on the Service and we use different types of cookies to run the Service:

- Essential cookies. We may use cookies to remember information that changes the way the Service behaves or looks, such as a user's language preference on the Service.
- Analytics cookies. We may use analytics cookies to track information how the Service is used so that we can make improvements. We may also use analytics cookies to test new advertisements, pages, features, or new functionality of the Service to see how our users react to them.
