Director Positions

The following petitions were received:

District 3 - Rural Director for Brown County

Incumbent Director Lori Goldade of Aberdeen filed petition for District 3. She has been a resident of Brown County for 25 years. Lori graduated from Ipswich High School and Northern State University. Lori is a retired USPS city letter carrier and currently works at the Brown County Treasurer's office. She is currently serving as a board member for the Sportsman's Club of Brown County and the Great Plains Outdoors. Lori has past experience serving on boards for many of the area's conservation groups and is also a founding member of Outdoor Women of South Dakota. When asked why she would like to serve on the WEB Water Board, Lori stated, "Serving on the Board for the past four years has been very rewarding. Being involved in the decision making to meet the goals of the organization has been a privilege. Learning the day to day process of the development; watching the managers and their team of employees working together to reach the needs of the members gives me a profound understanding of what it takes to run a major water system. I look forward to the opportunity to serve another term; to see our goals met, to see moratoriums cease, all while keeping costs to our members within reason."

District 4 - Rural Director for Campbell & McPherson Counties in SD and Emmons, Dickey & McIntosh Counties in ND

Dick Werner of Herreid filed petition for District 4. He has been a resident of Campbell County for 6 years. Werner graduated from Herreid High School and from University of South Dakota with a Business Administration degree. He currently owns and operates his family farm and co-owns a power line construction company and is the president of the Herreid Area Housing Development, Inc. When asked why he would like to serve on the WEB Water Board, Werner stated, "I would like to continue my service on the WEB Board through the expansion project, so WEB can allow new hookups in the current moratorium areas and allow for future development."

District 7 - Bulk Director for McPherson, Edmunds, Faulk, Campbell, Walworth, Potter & Hyde Counties in SD and Emmons & McIntosh Counties in ND

Henry Orth of Eureka filed petition for District 7. He has been a resident of McPherson County for 30 years and graduated from Herreid High School. Orth does custom hay grinding and helps a neighbor with general farm work in the summers. He's a current and past member of the Eureka City Council, a past member of the Zion Lutheran Church council and a past JC member. When asked why he would like to serve on the WEB Water Board, Orth stated, "I want to see the water system continue & possibly grow. I know from experience a lot of towns have not used their wells, or very little, in years. Without WEB Water, a lot of towns would have great expense getting wells back on line."
